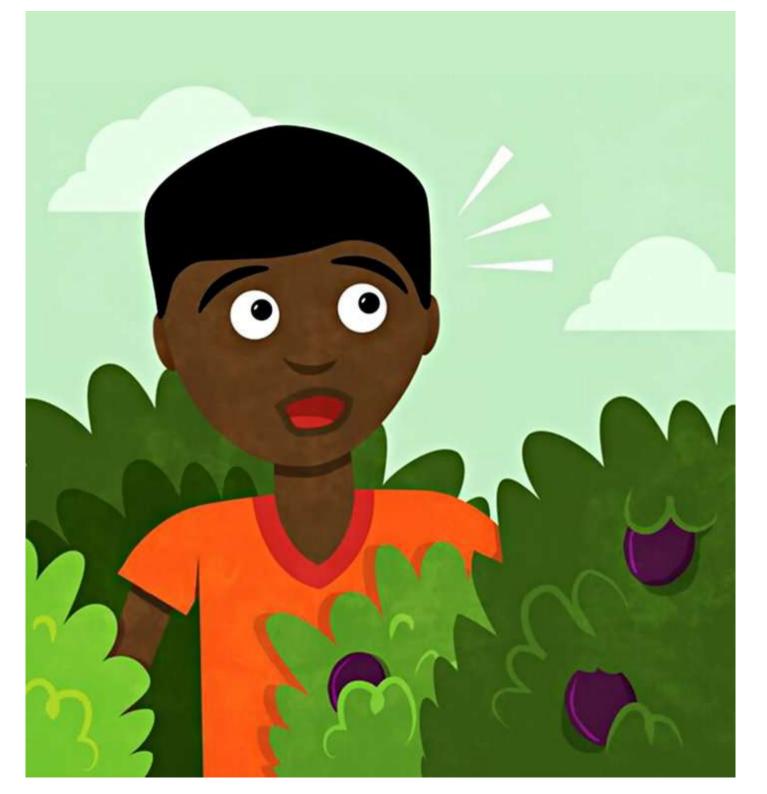

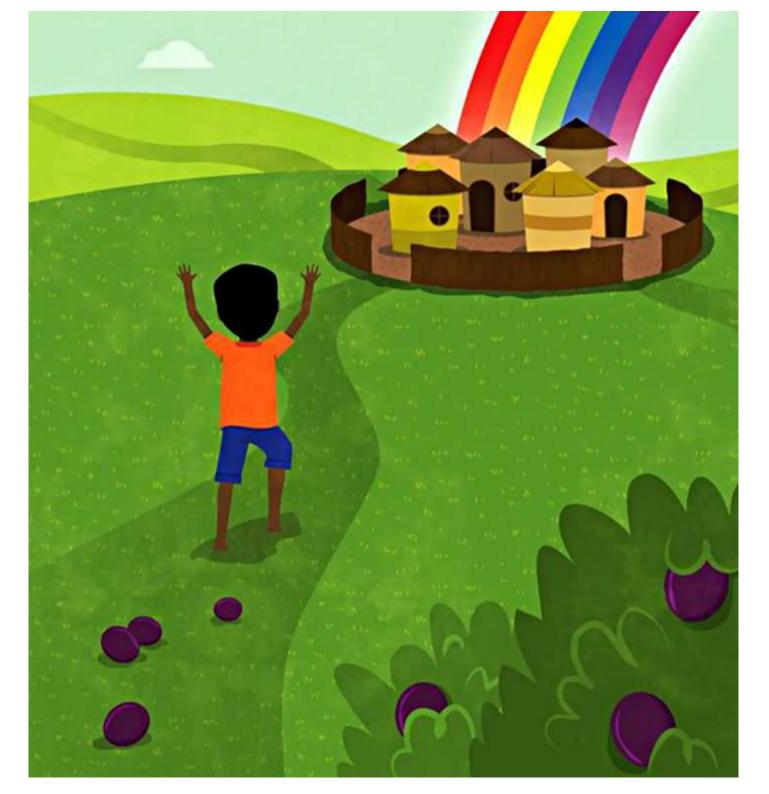
My name is Kobole. I live in a small village.
