Chinti ,her brother Montu and her friends were well known for their bravery.




Chinti and Montu along with their friends decide that they will search for the ghost at night.

Montu and ritesh search behind the broken wall.




Suddenly a flock of bats came towards Ritesh. He screamed and ran away and told everything to Montu.


