






Oh, todos estamos vestidos del mismo color hoy! ¡Ven, veamos otros colores!

Aquí, Ben está cortando berenjenas púrpuras.




Sara tiene limones amarillos del sol.




Los colores son divertidos de ver. Ahora a comer algo colorido también! ¡Sabroso!

¿Debemos comer un popsicle rosado?




¿O un helado blanco cremoso?




O podemos beber un delicioso jugo verde.
