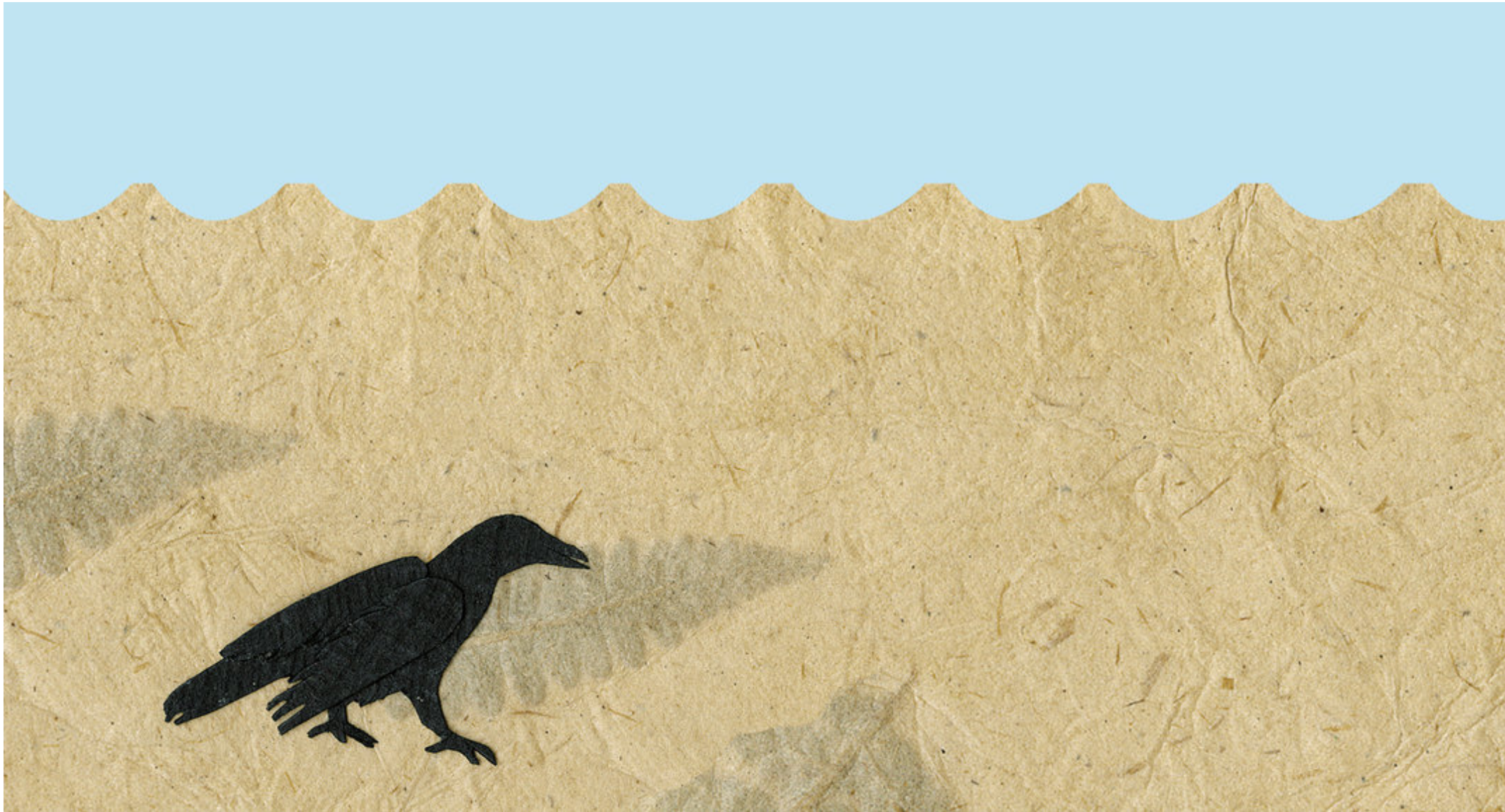

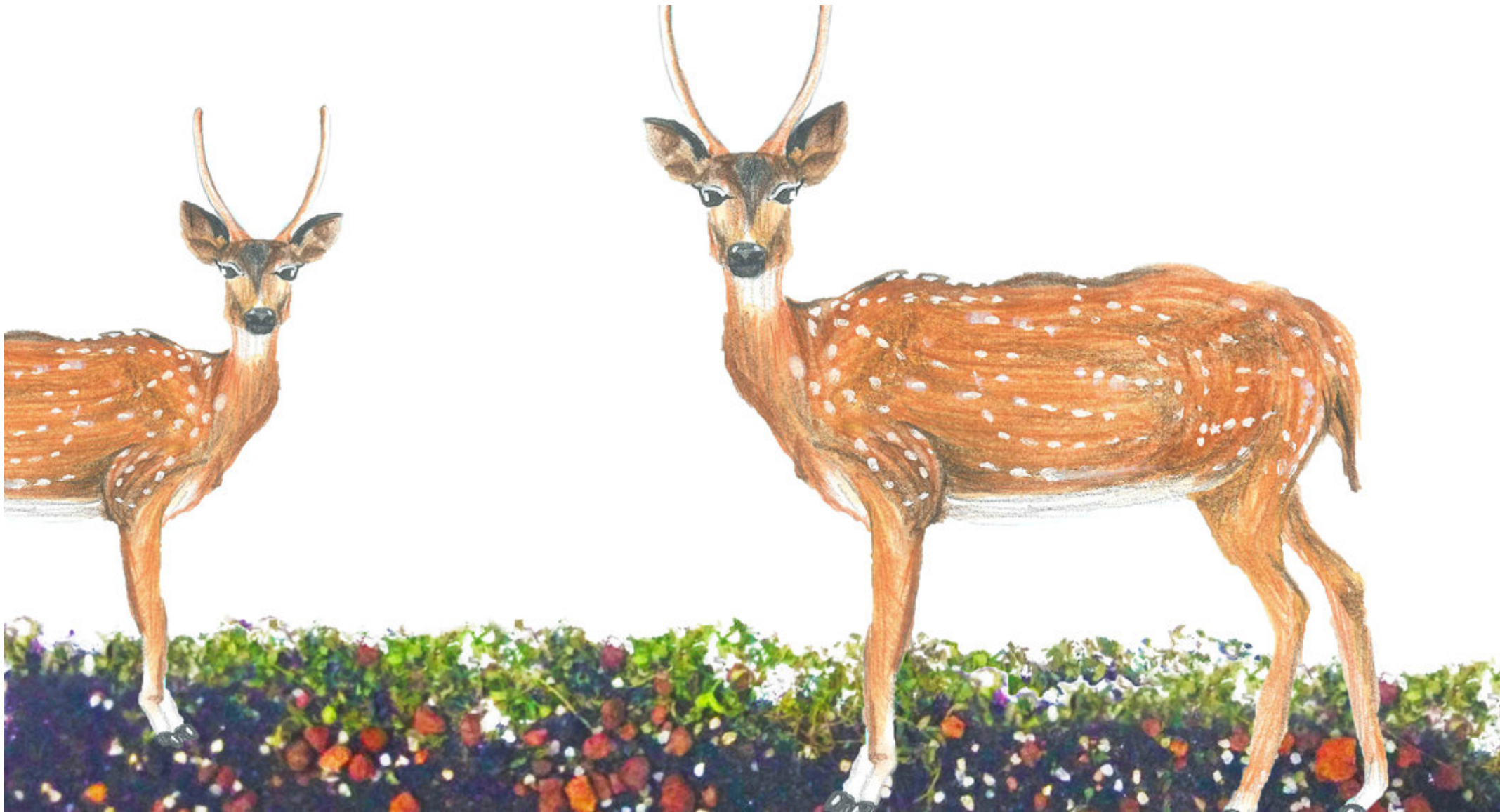




**Verde**, como este viejo y frondoso árbol.
