Babu Kutty the Farmer is not back yet. The animals are getting very hungry!






The pig holds a meeting.

She takes a nice bath.




"Kukadoo-koo!" the rooster crows, running around excitedly.

Babu Kutty comes running.


"What is all that noise?" he wonders.
