I am very brave and I never give up! I always think bravely and believe that I am brave.




I was enjoying the sound of the ocean hitting the sand, until a flying fish jumped out of the water in need of help!


I never give up on problems so I wanted to help him.




Scared and sad, the flying fish told me the moon had fallen from the sky. I knew I had to venture deep into the ocean to find the moon!





The ocean is beautiful and I was very fortunate to see it all! I promised I will never give up no matter how hard the problem is.




