Entonces, ella trató de ponerlos en el fuego.

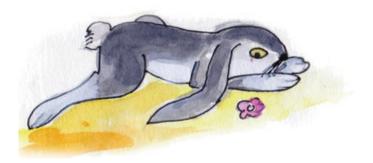
Cuando los probó, ¡estaban amargos!
