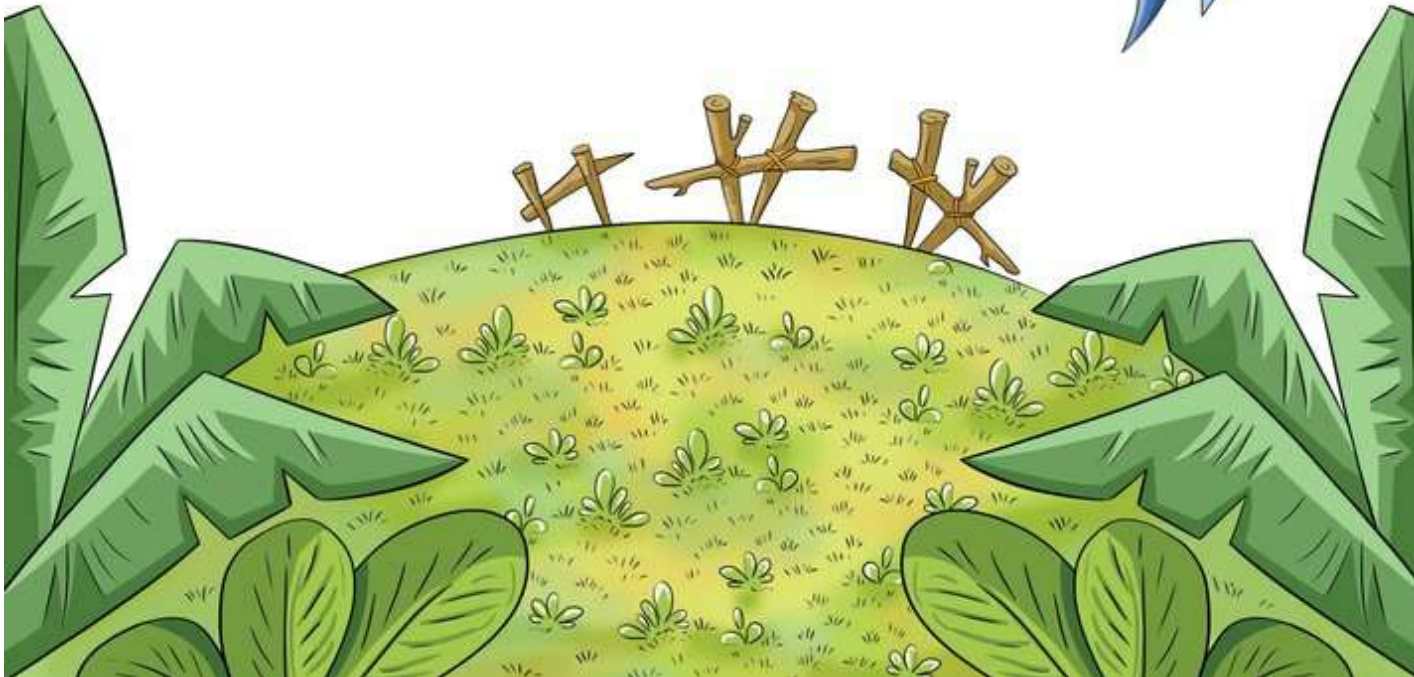

Parrot can fly.





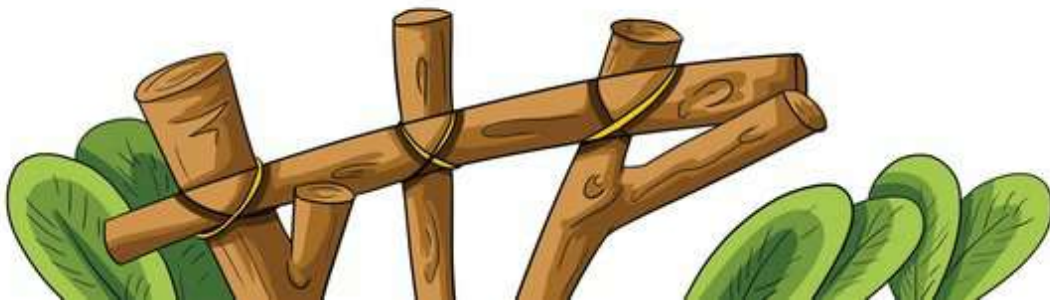


Horse cannot fly.

Pelican can fly.



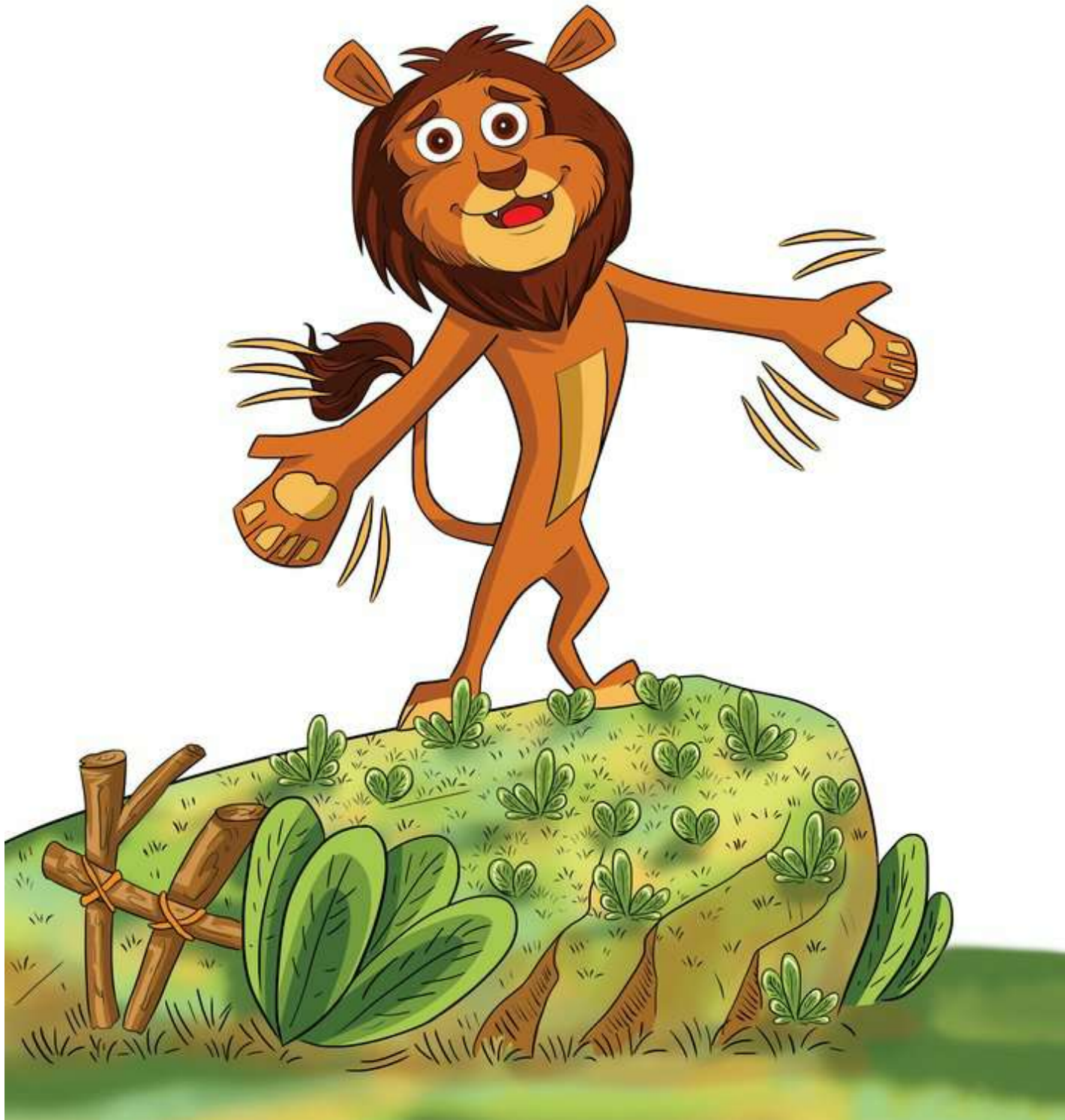
Gibbon cannot fly.
