On Monday, Billy was sitting outside his house where he saw some sparrows flying. He imagined that he was flying like those sparrows and talking to them.




On Tuesday, Billy went to the garden and saw a beautiful butterfly, He imagined that he had colourful wings like a butterfly and he was fluttering around the flowers.
