People pushed to get on the bus.

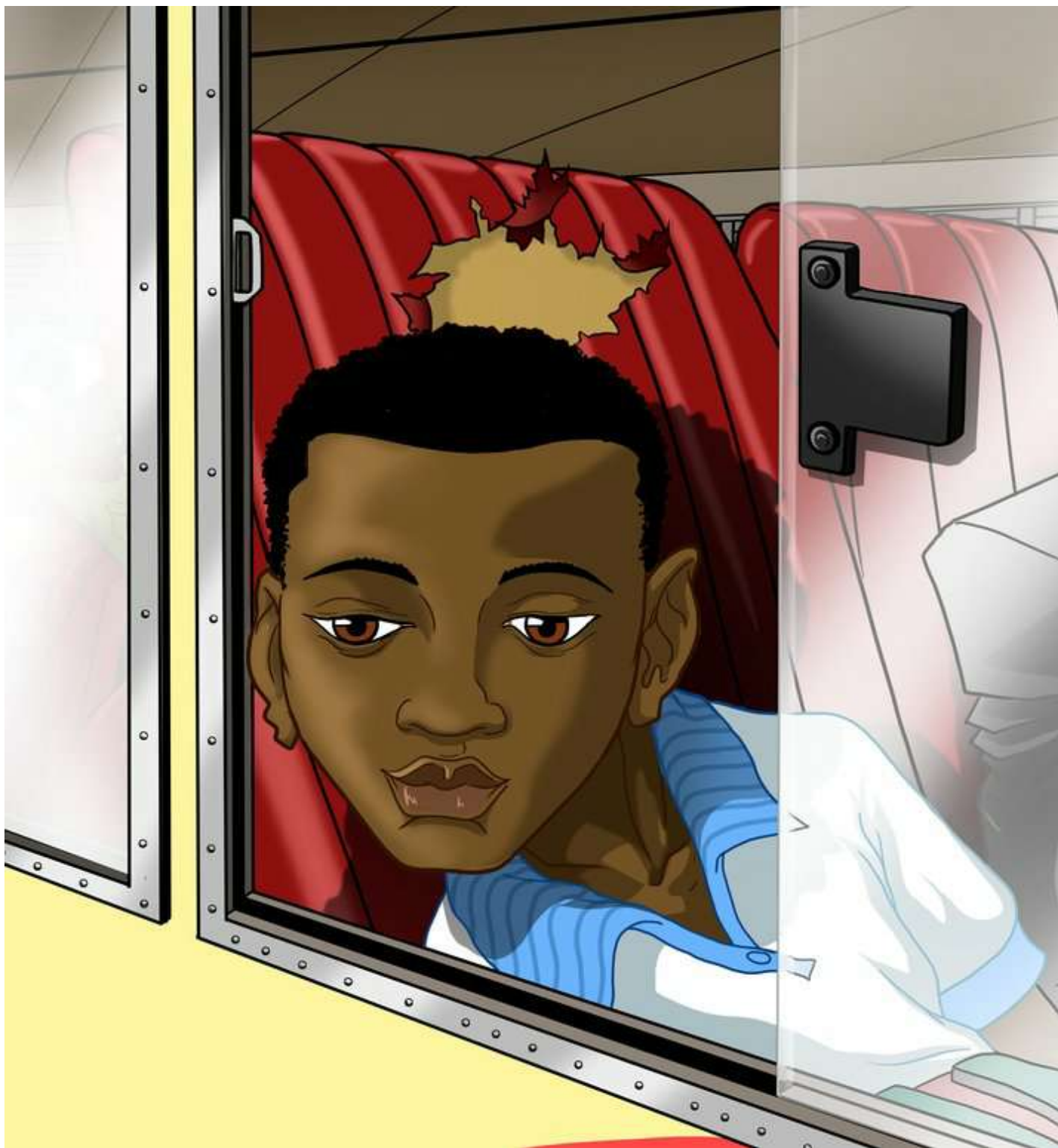


Women with
children sat down.

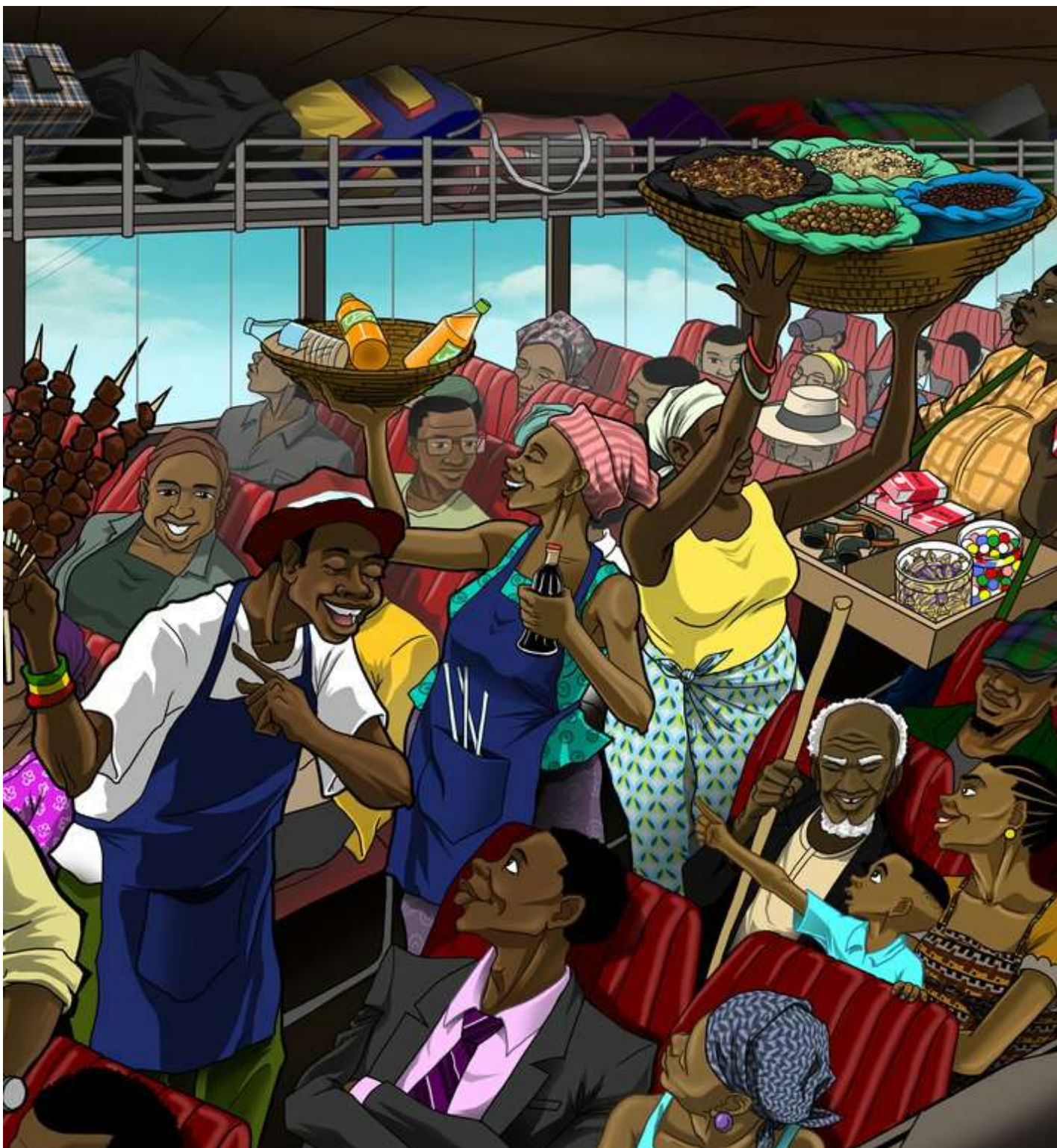
The journey was

I had no money to buy anything.

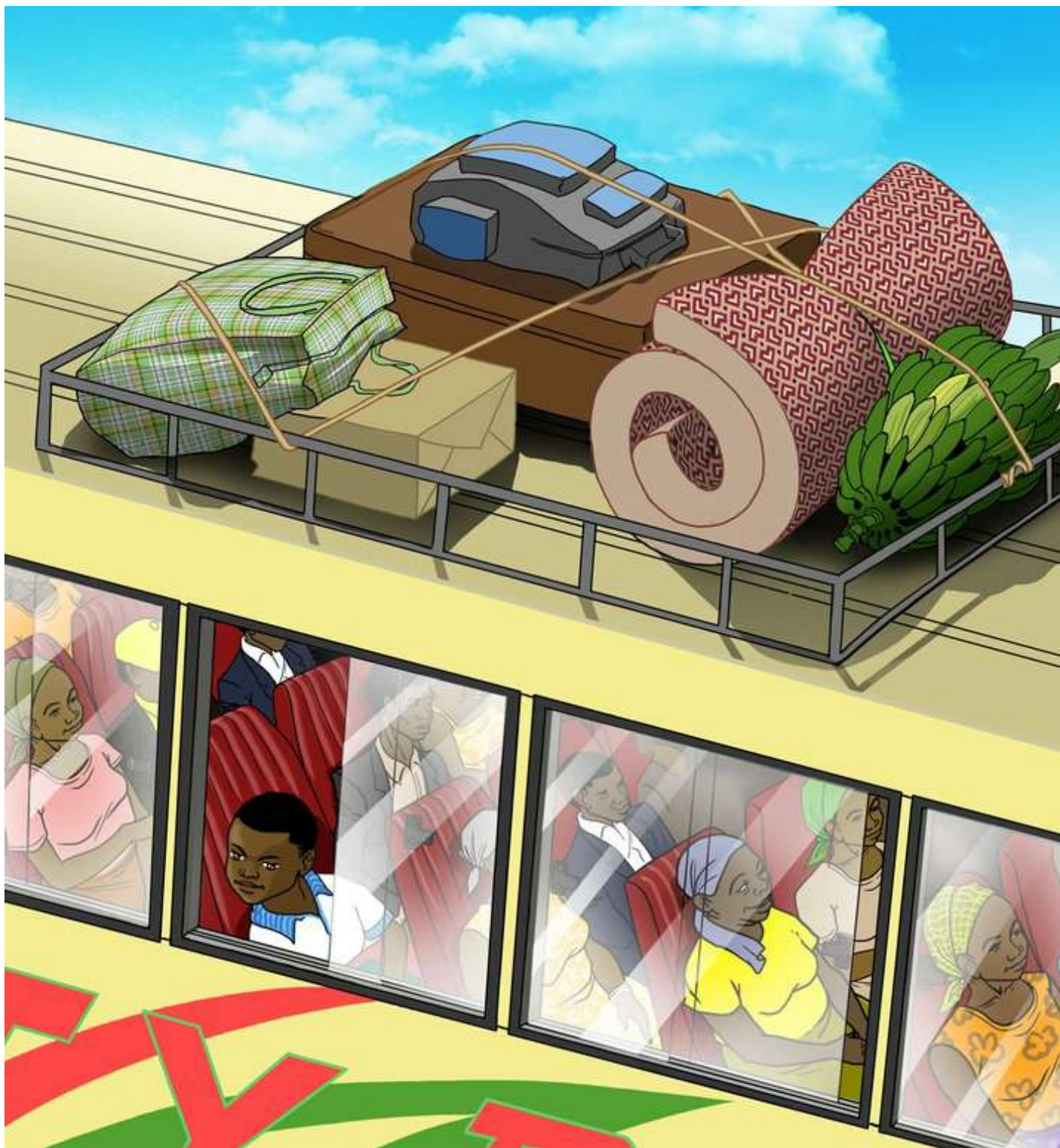


Suddenly, the driver

The hawkers pushed each other to get out of the bus.

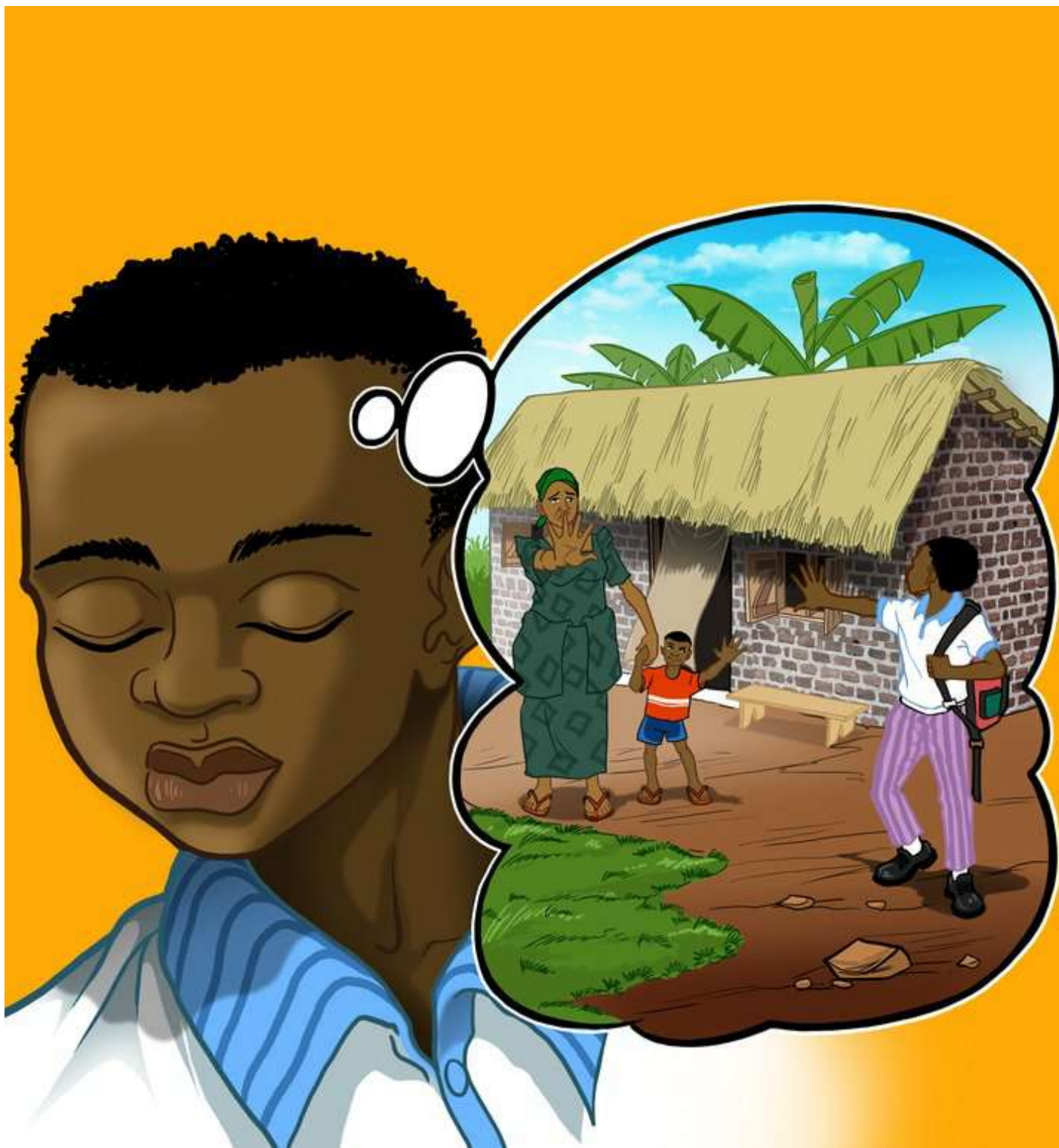


“When will I return?” I asked myself.



It was hot inside the bus.

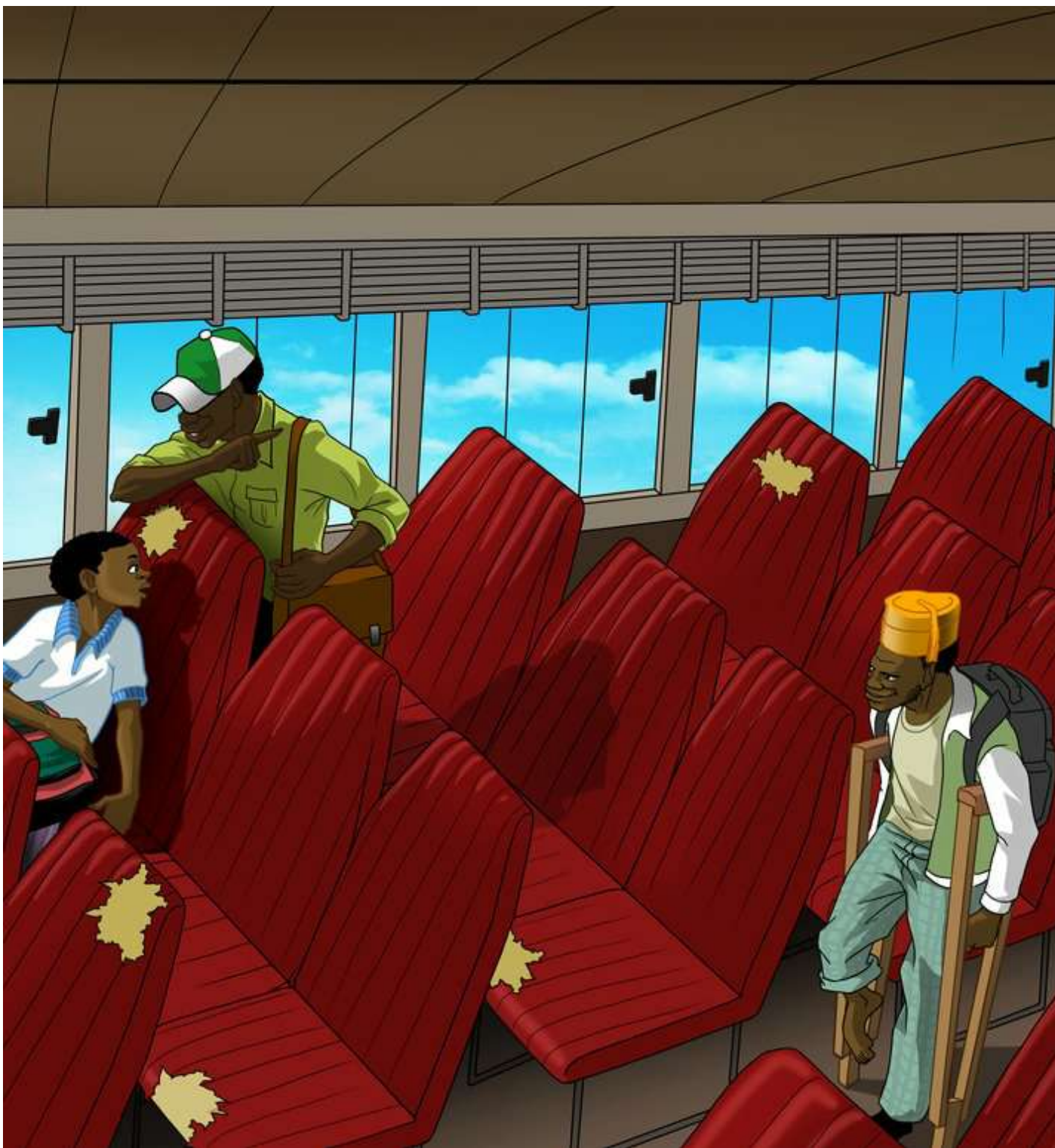
I closed my eyes.

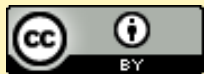

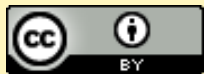
