I can't wait to spend time with my mother!



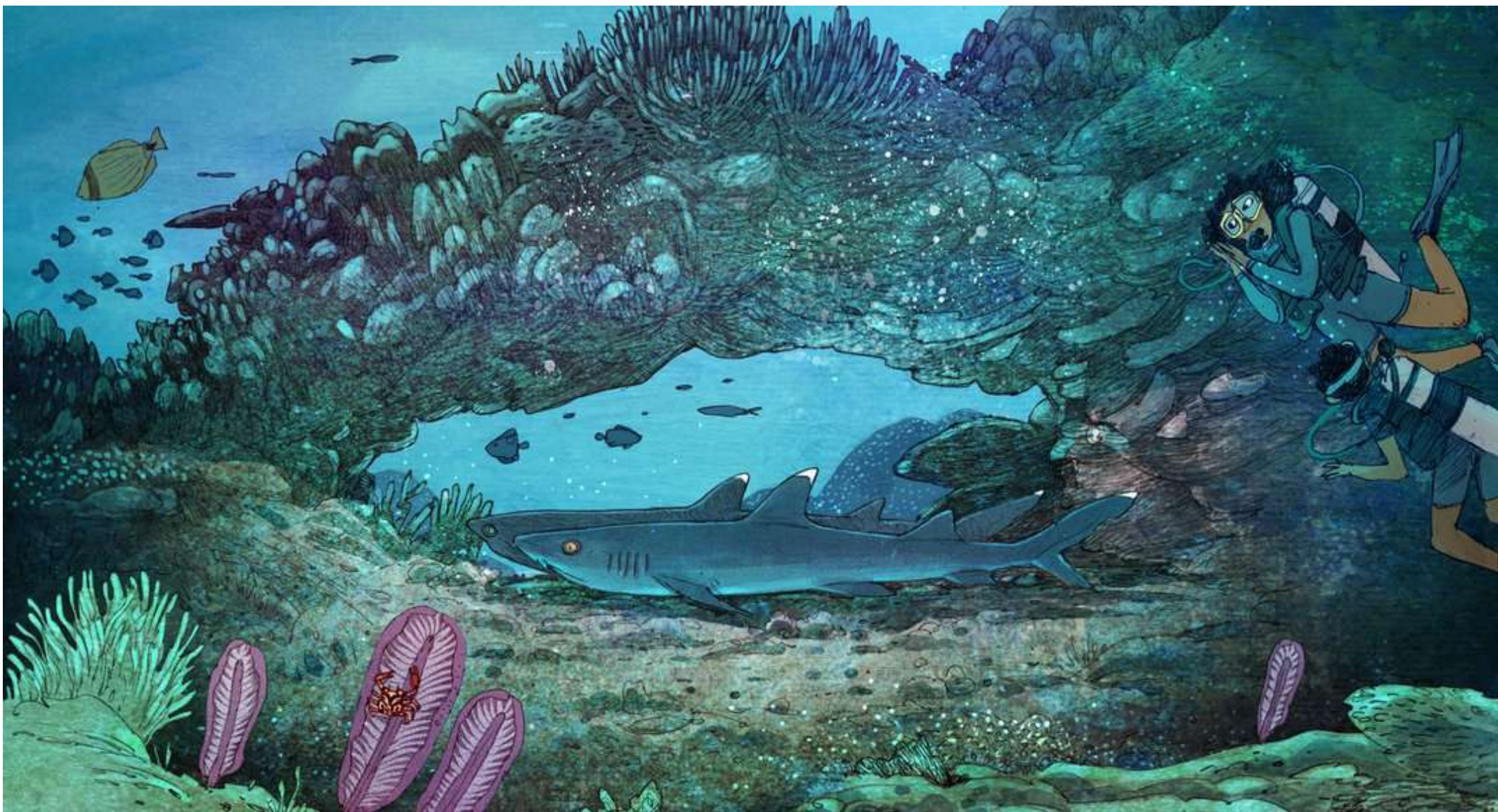


We took a boat and went to see the fish and the coral reefs underwater!
