Annie estaba dormida en su cama, cuando de repente escucho un ruido alto.




El ruido paro y Annie desperto. No penso nada y se volvio a acostar.




Otro ruido alto sucedió y eso despertó a Annie.

Annie se levantó y los monstruos la vieron. Salieron corriendo del cuarto.




Annie sonrió y los monstruos se escondieron. Annie se salió de la cama y fue por ellos.
