"¡Es una cara sonriente!", Dice ella.


Abuela aplaude. "¡Entendiste el juego!"





“¡Mira lo que he dibujado!” dice Jeenu.


Actividad: ¿Qué puedes dibujar con tres círculos?

“¡Bien hecho, Jeenu!” dice Abuela. “¡Mira quién ha venido a jugar con nosotros!”


Actividad: ¿Qué puedes dibujar con tres círculos y cuatro triángulos?


Abuela dibuja una forma con cuatro lados.

"¡Es un cuadrado! Hmmm ... mira Abuela, he dibujado una ventana".






“¿Quieres un árbol cerca de tu ventana?” pregunta Abuela.


“Sí, Aiji, ¡gracias!” dice Jeenu.
