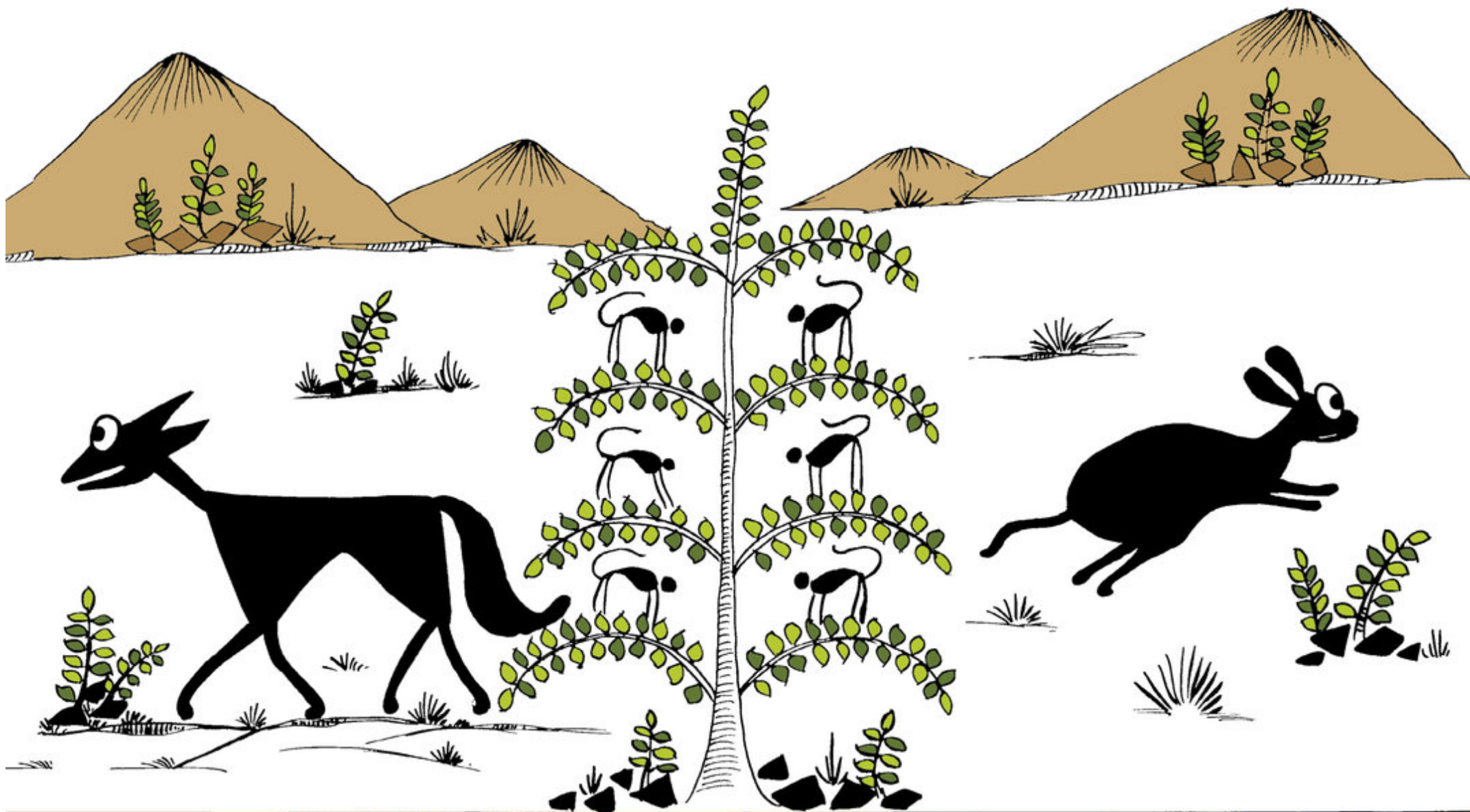

El conejo dijo, "vamos a buscarle un cangrejo!"



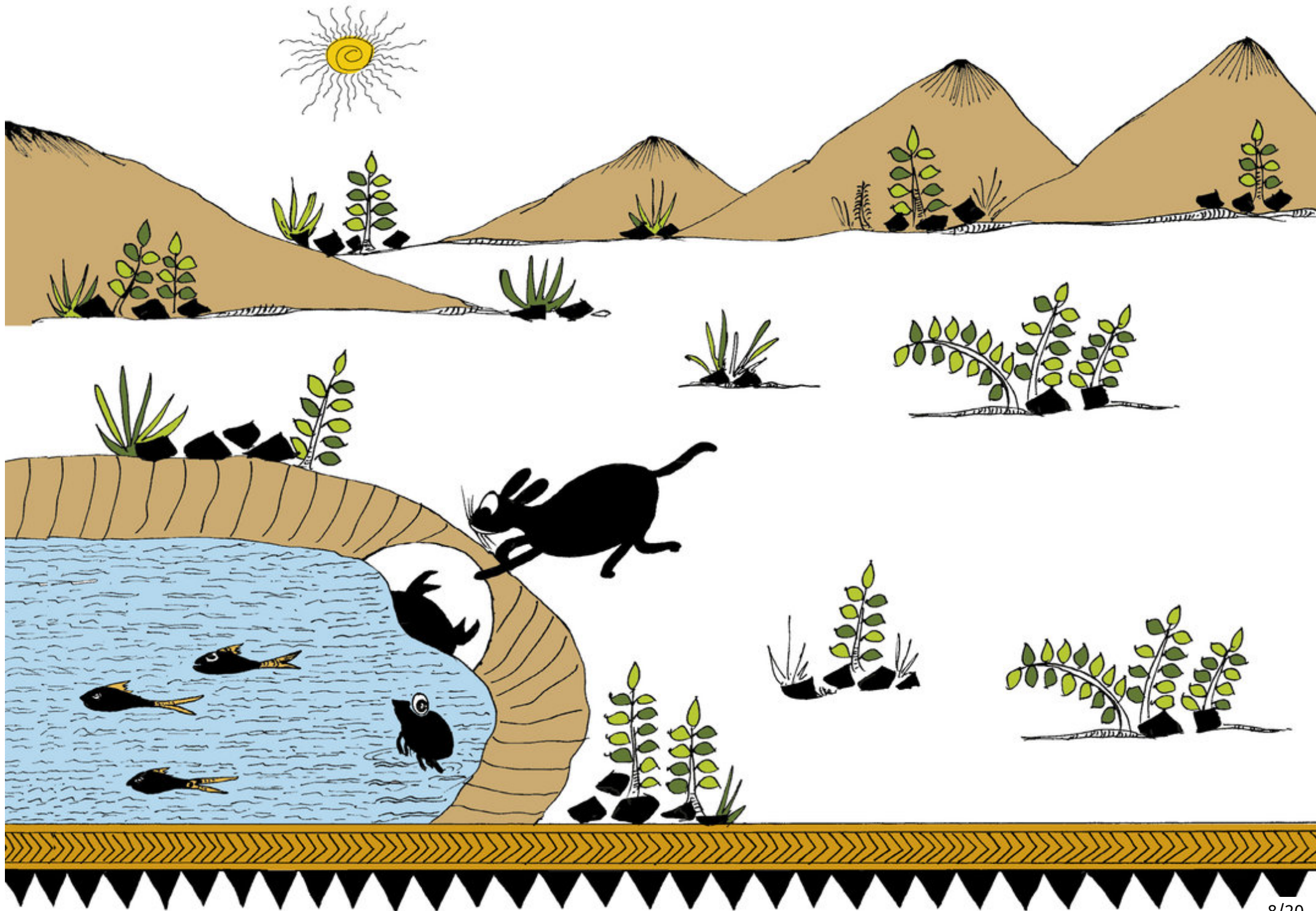
Los dos fueron a buscar el cangrejo. El conejo se fue a un lado y el chacal se fue al otro.

Con mucho cuidado metió la mano dentro del hoyo.



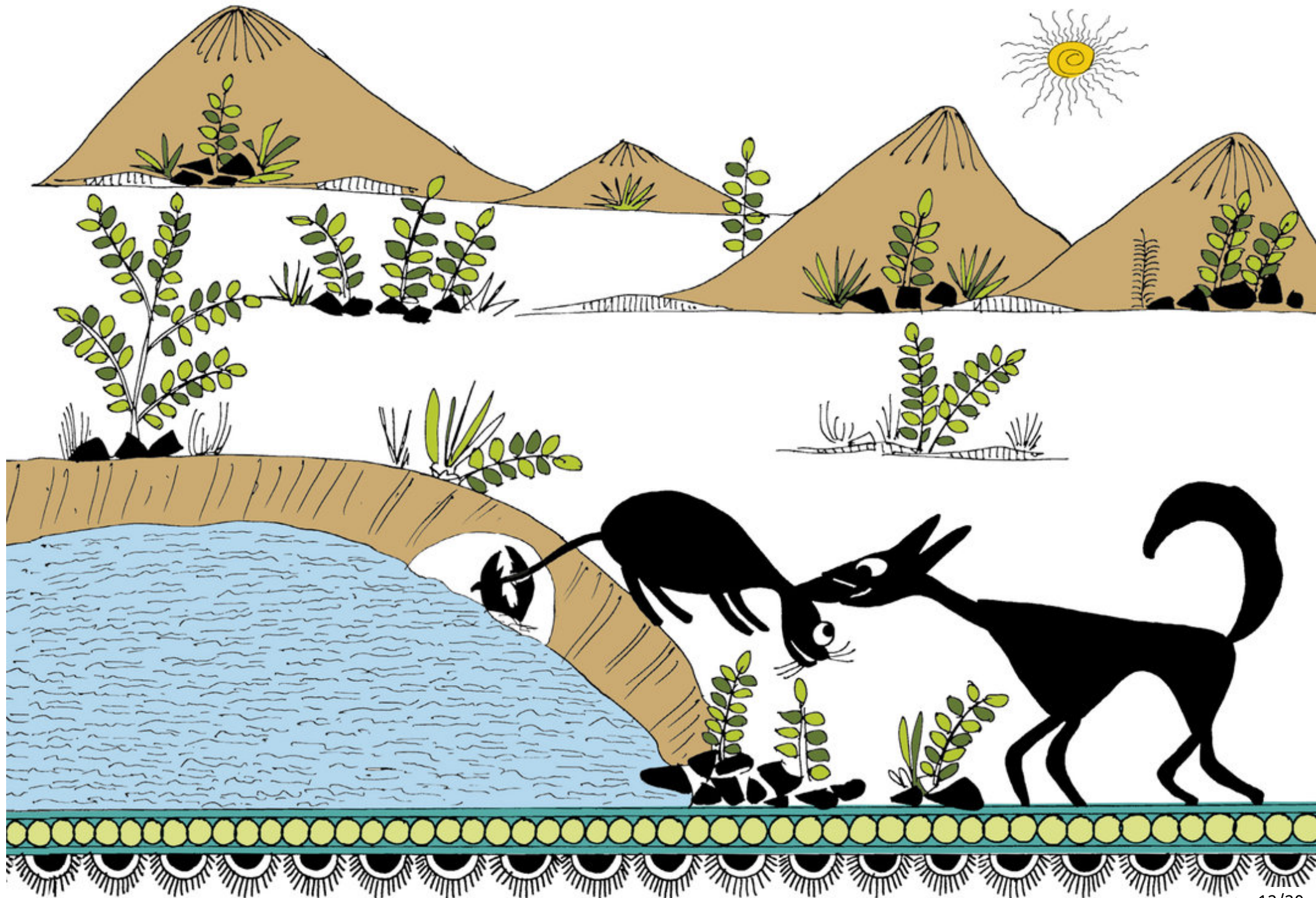
Cuando su mano no pudo alcanzar el cangrejo, decidio meter su cola.



El cangrejo le mordía la cola. Le dolió tanto que gritó el conejo. El chacal los escuchó y salió corriendo.



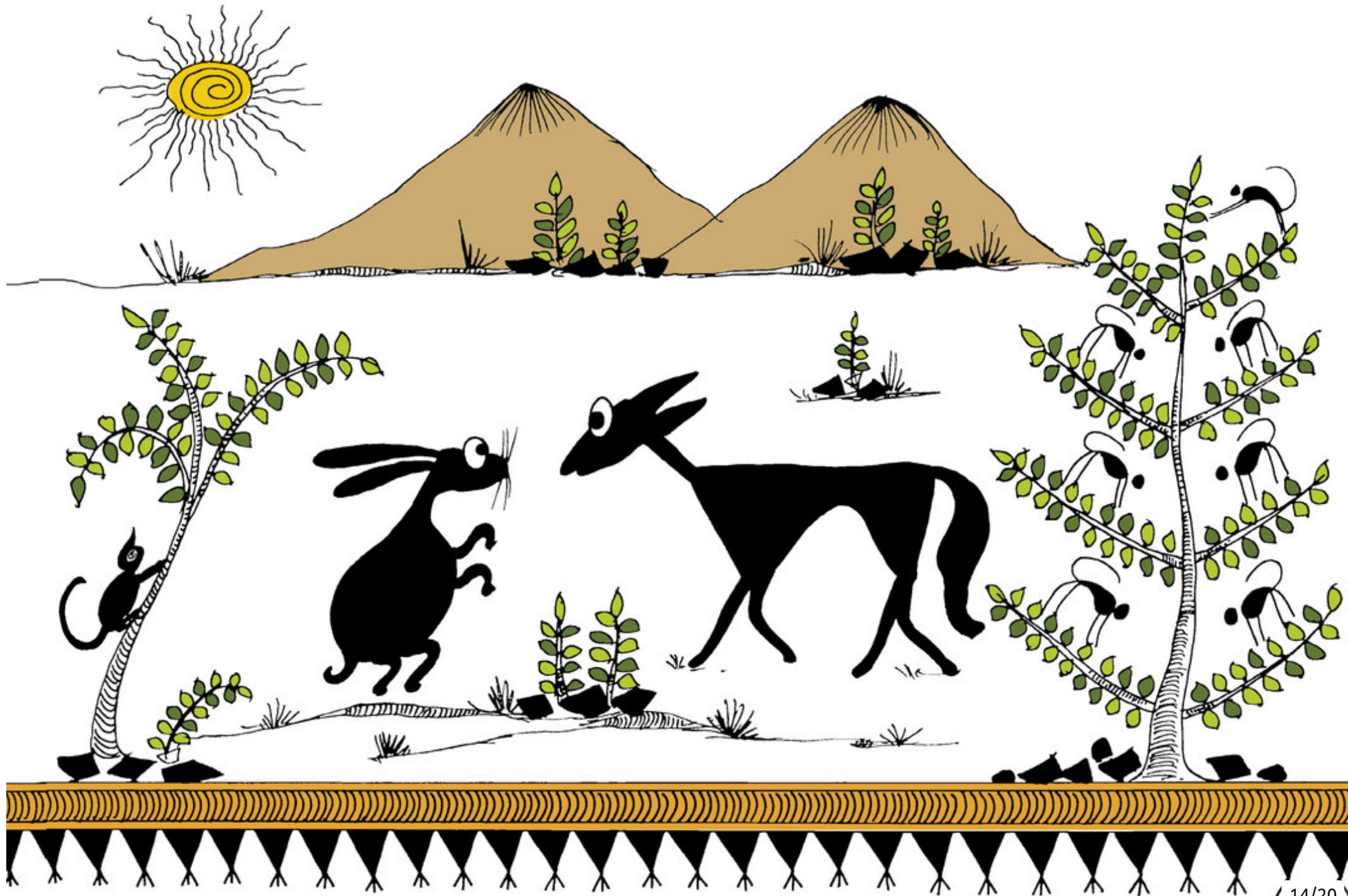
El conejo suspiro, "No te quedes parado, ayudame!"

La cola se le cortó y se quedó dentro del hoyo.

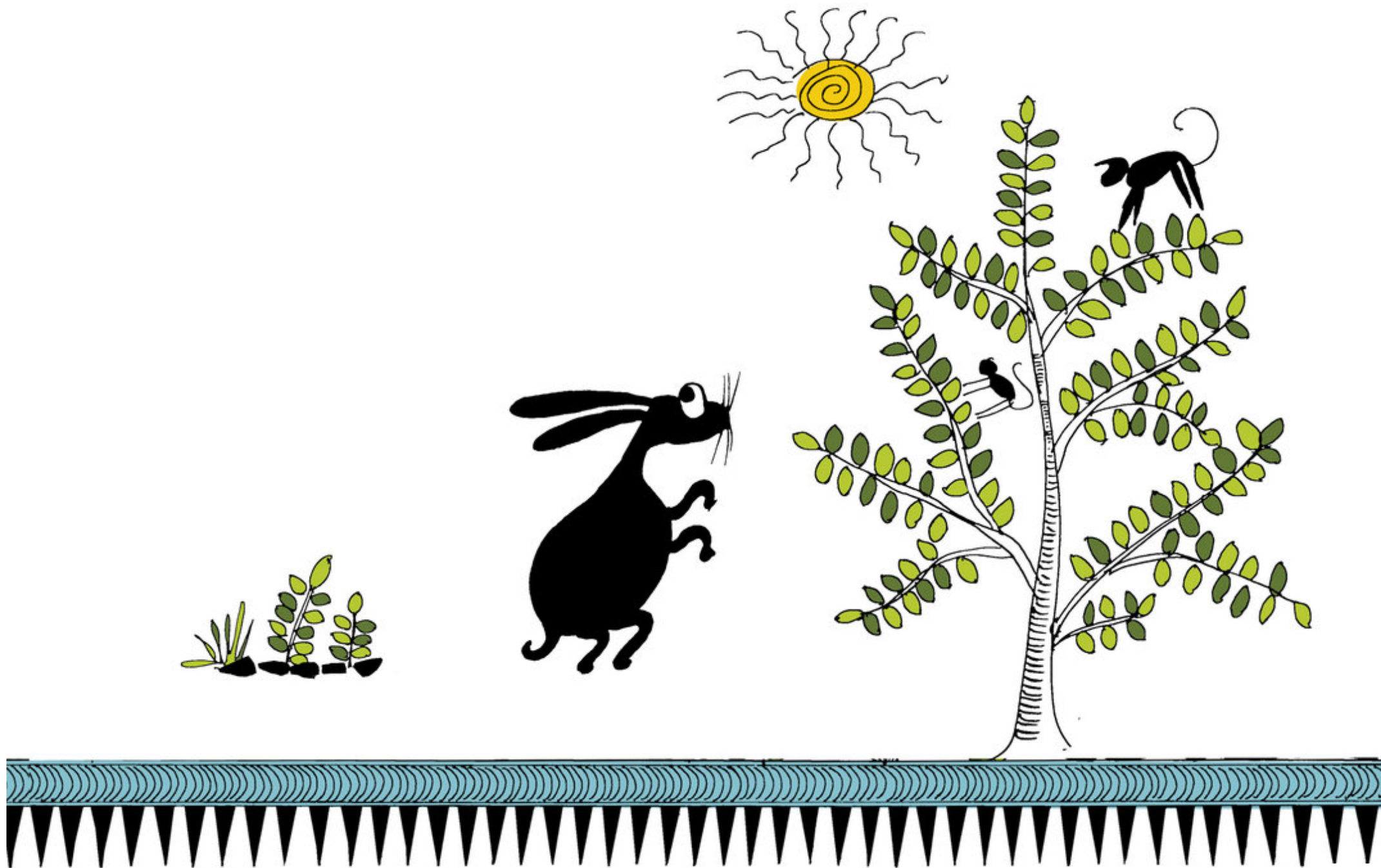


Sus orejas crecieron después de que el chacal las jalo.
