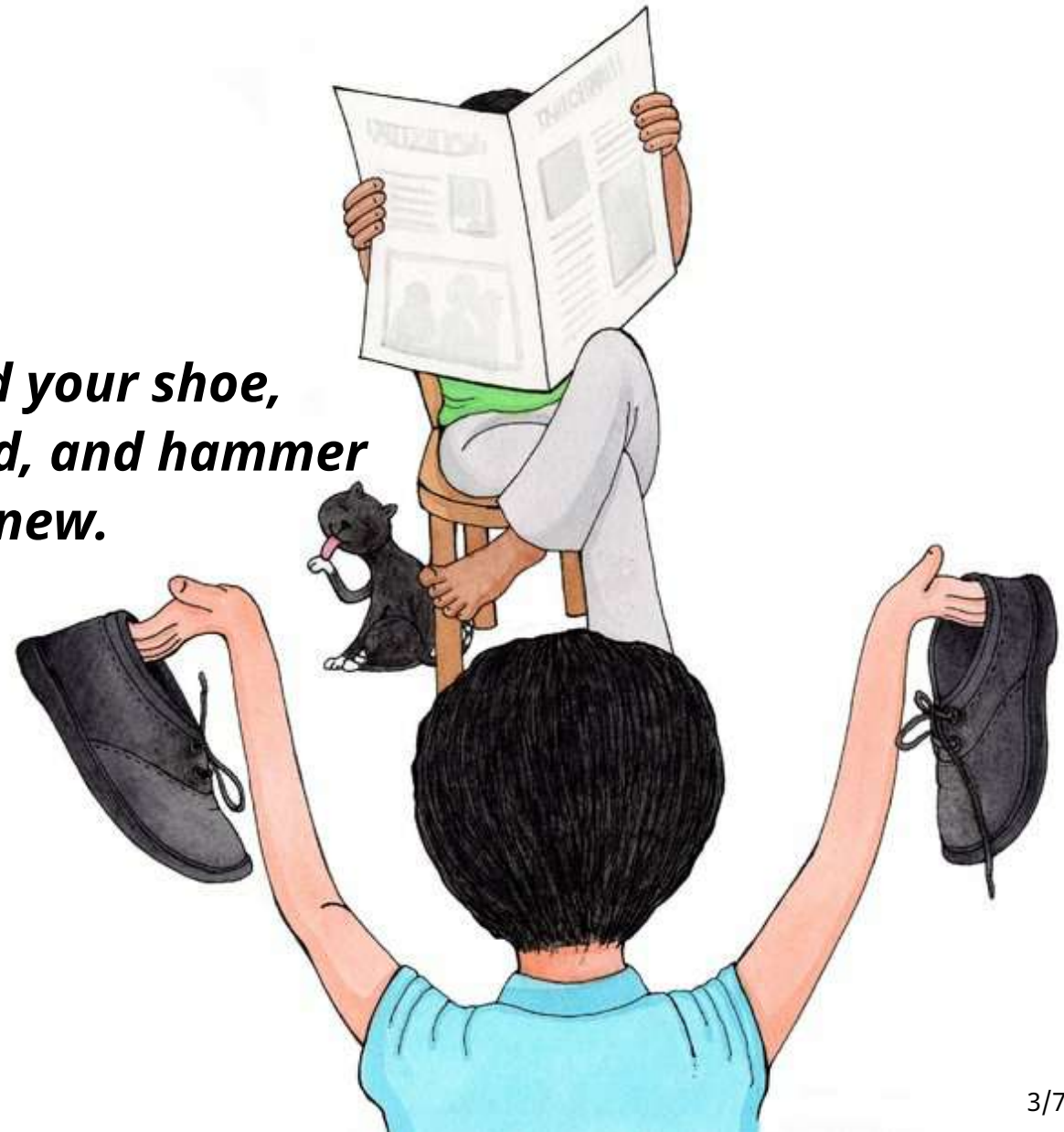

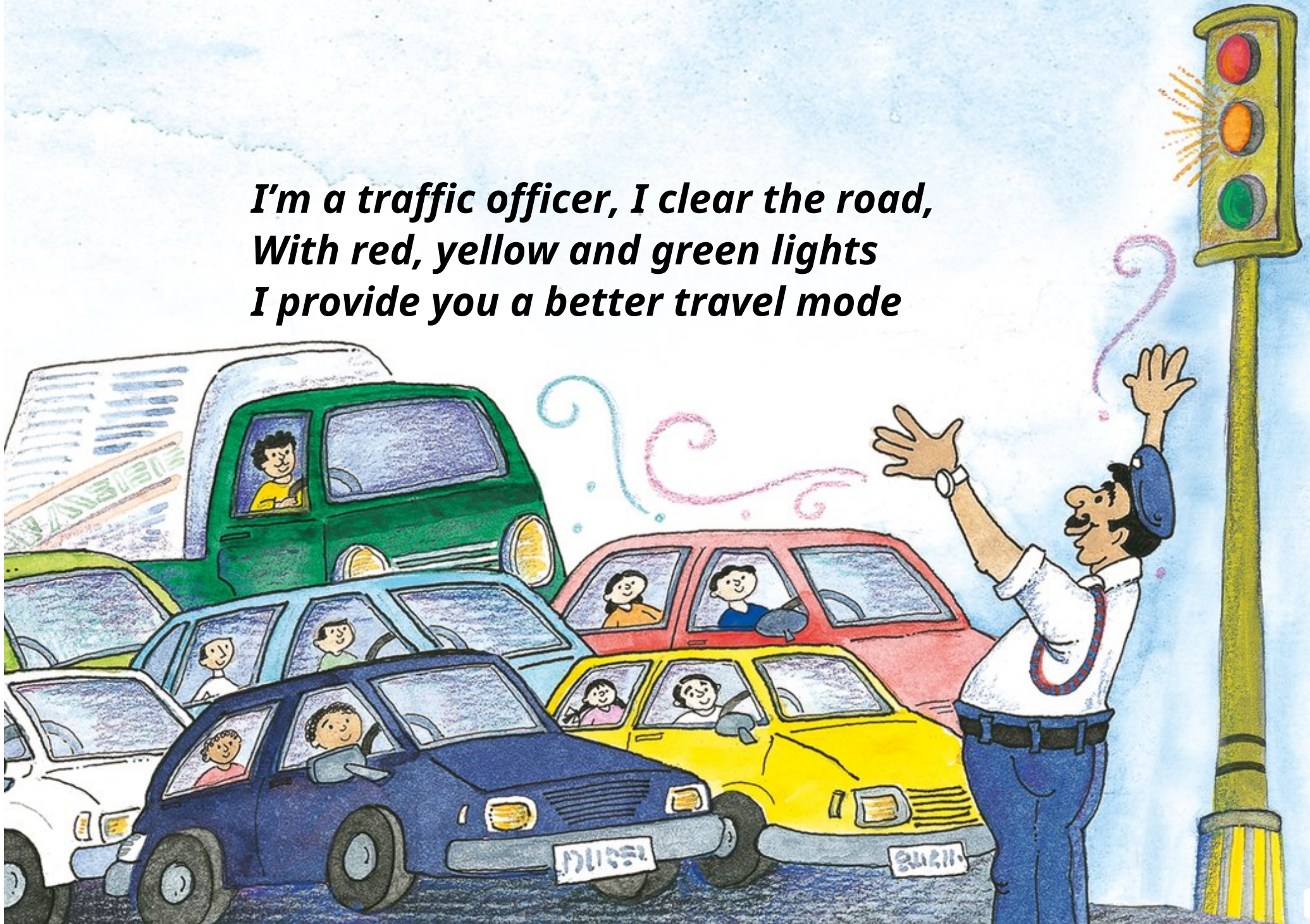
***I'm a tailor I make clothes.

That's how my thread goes.***



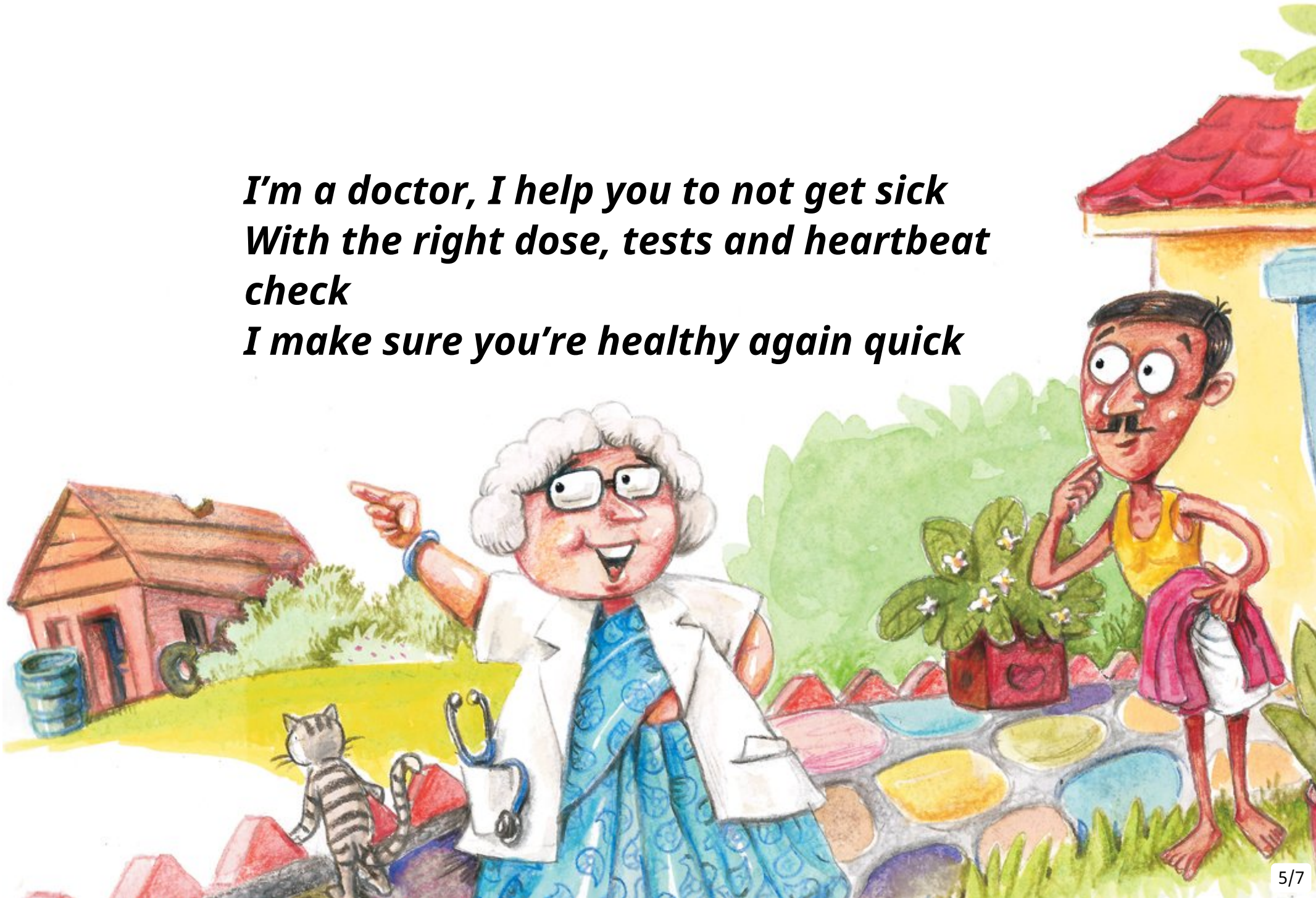
***I'm a cobbler I mend your shoe,

I make them brand new.***




***I'm a traffic officer, I clear the road,
