Your salary also helps to pay bills such as house rent, electricity bill, internet bill, school fees, hospital expenses, and many more.



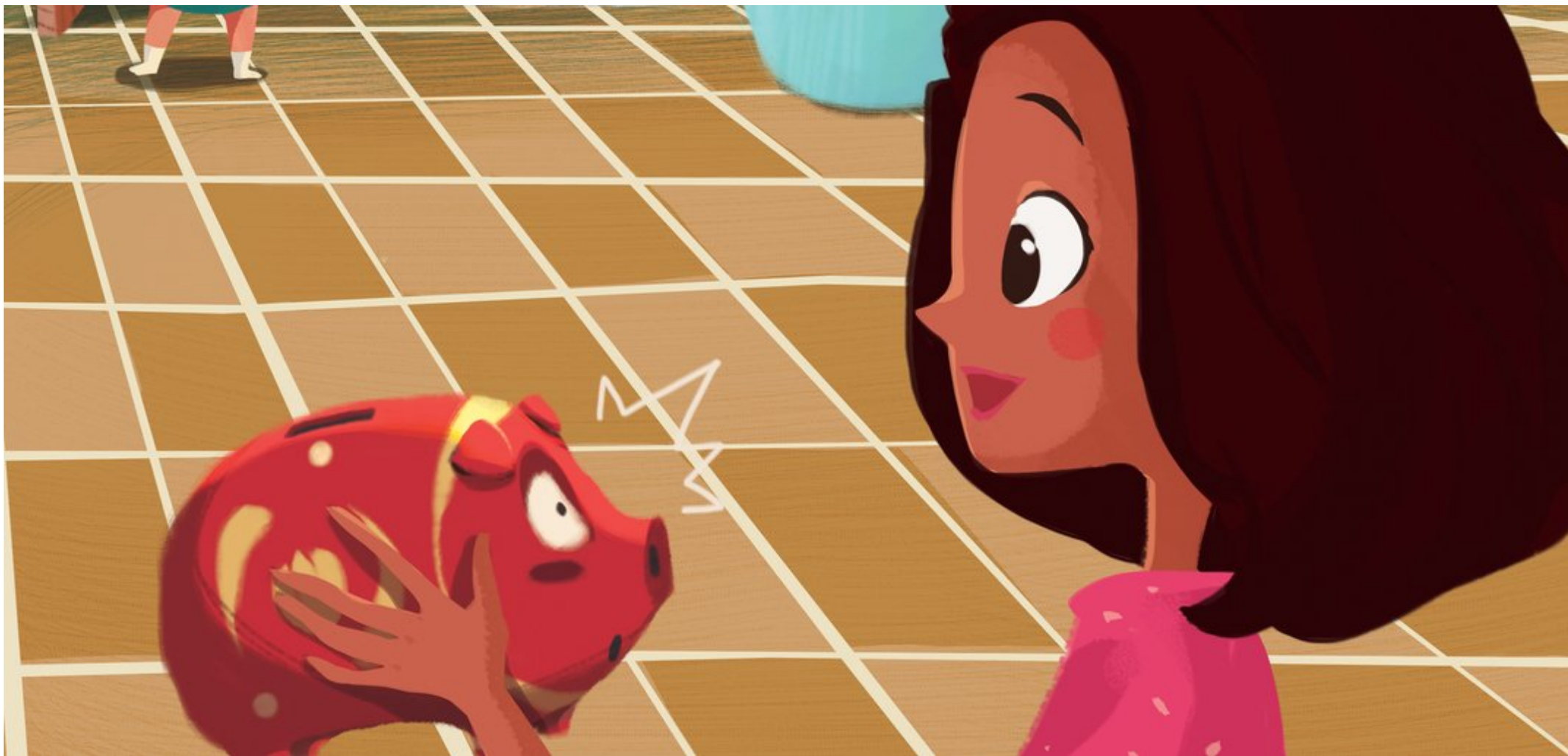
A job allows you to exhibit your skills and talents.
