


"¡Hola, amigos!" dice Douangkeo. Sus nombres son Duoangta, Khamla y Khonesavan.

¡Ella quiere ser maga porque le encantan los espectáculos de magia!




¡Pero ella no sabe qué hacer! No tiene las herramientas que un mago necesita.
