Para a oler las flores frescas.






Practican a montar con bebes elefantes y caballos.




Juegan fútbol y a las escondidas en el pasto alto.




Excavan en los camps y recogen verduras.



Los cocodrilos amables ponen sus huevos por la orilla y los cuida.




Las hormigas colectan residuos y regresan a sus colonias.
