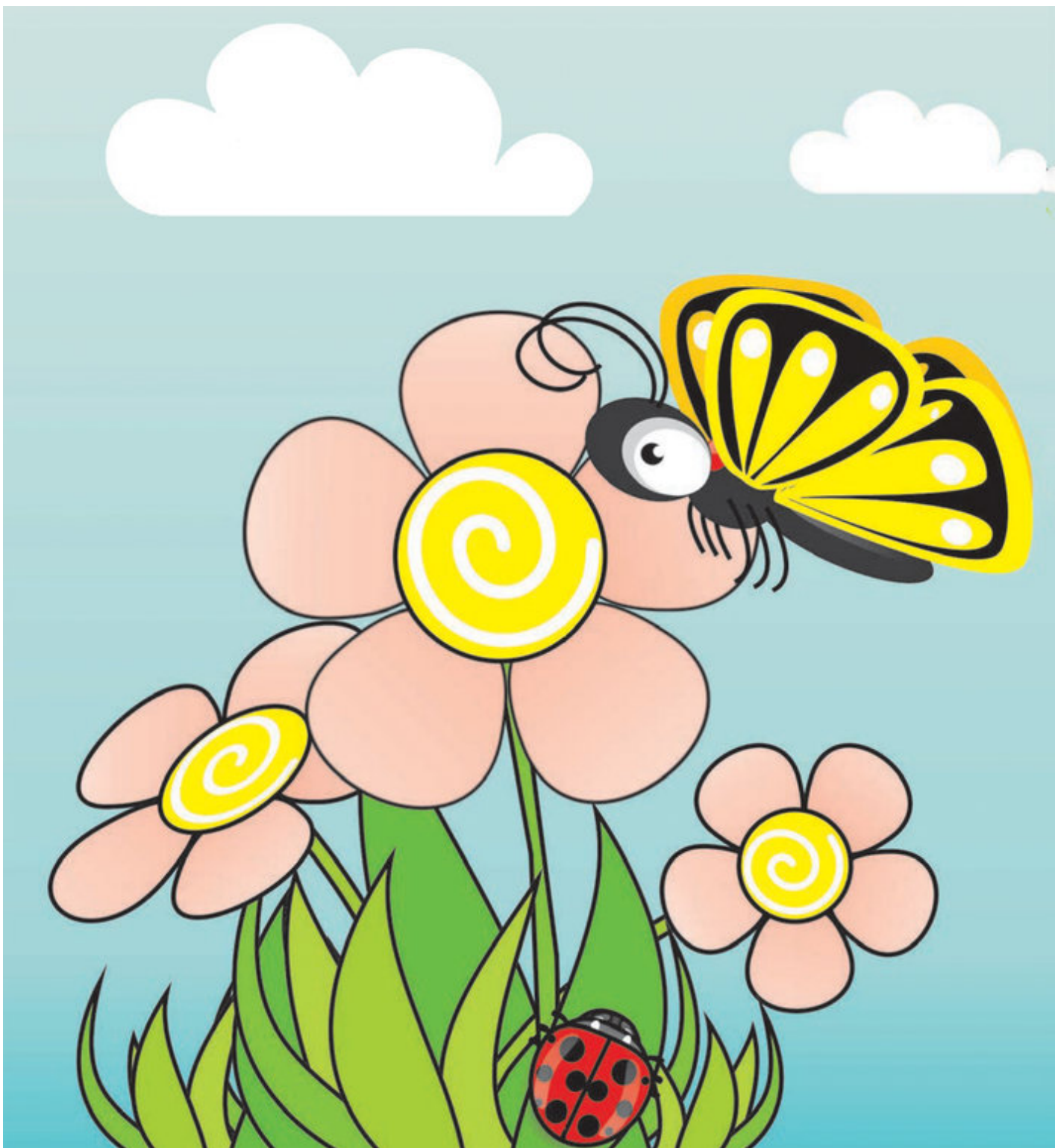

insect.



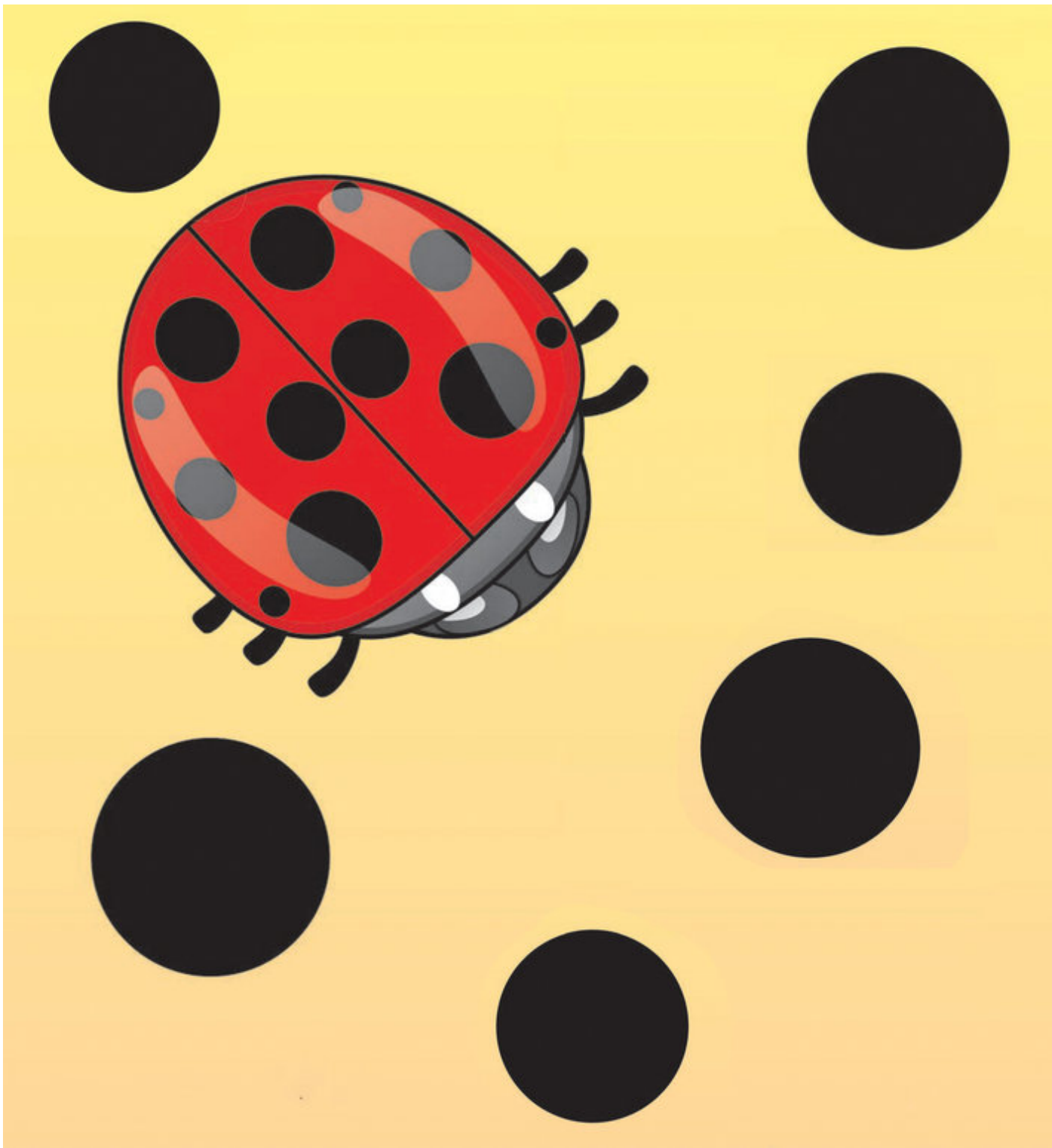
It's not an insect

It has spots which are equal in shape and size. It has a red body with black spots.



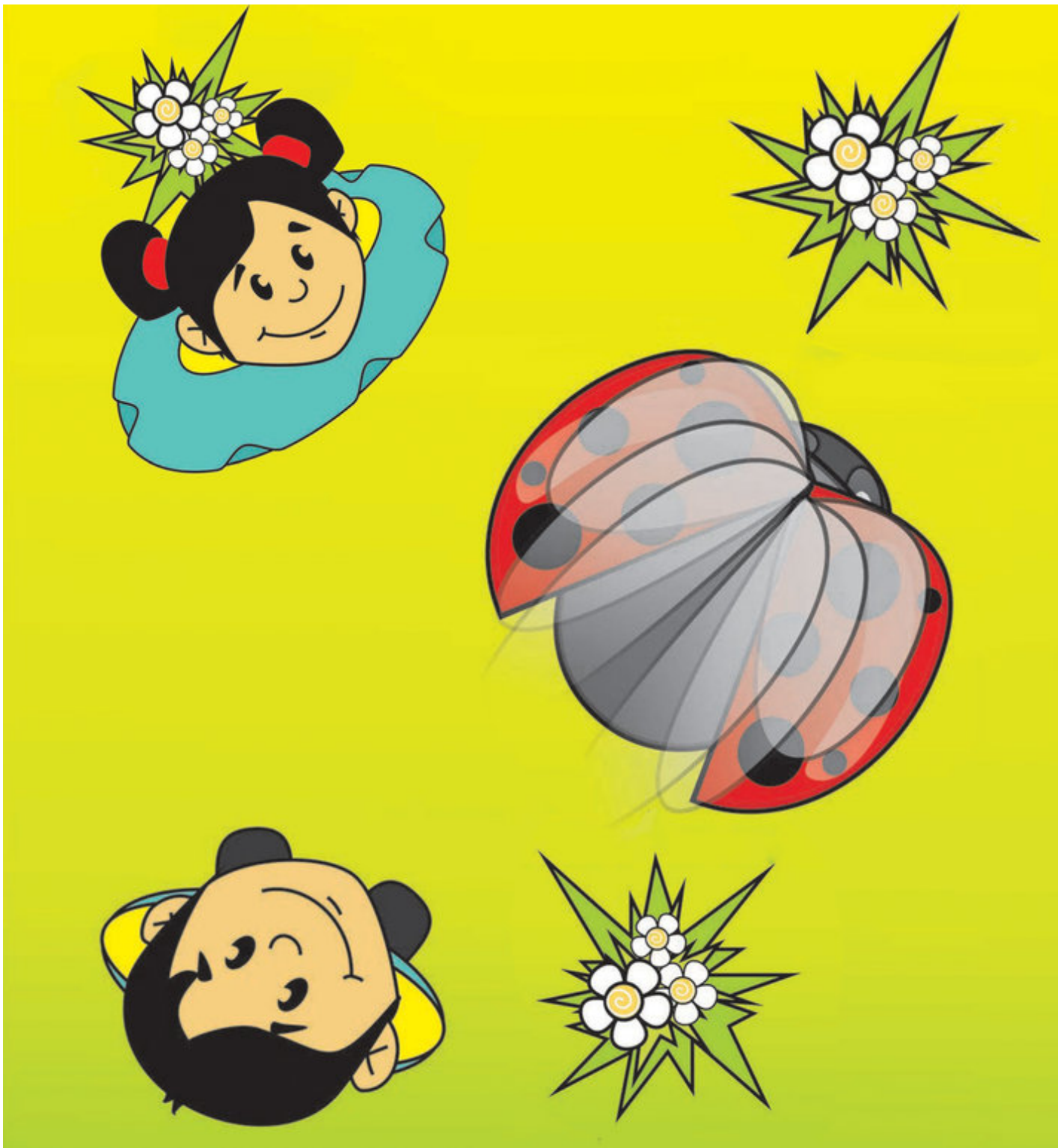
Ladybird, how did

over your body?



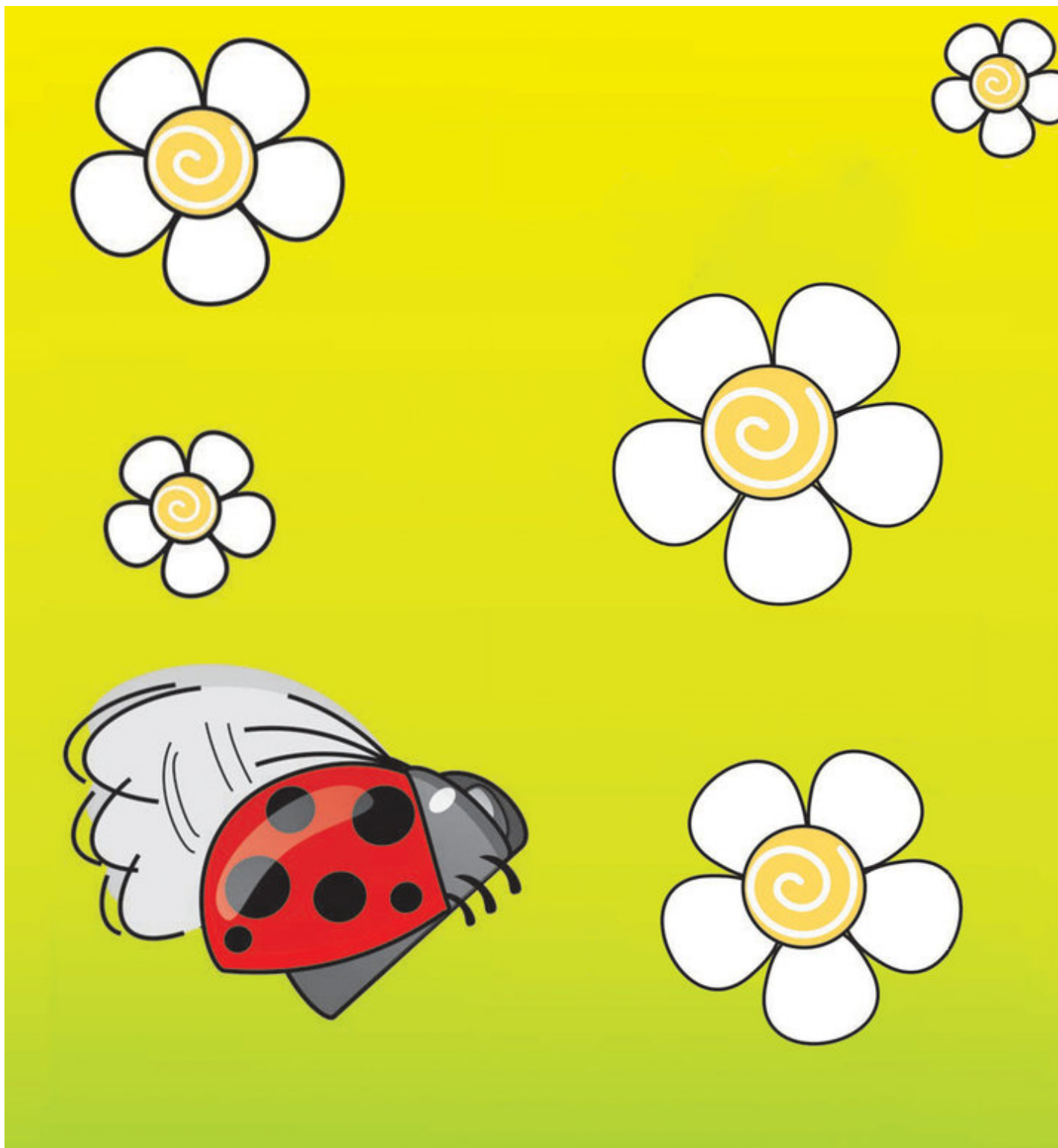
Did you get them yourself?
