“Oh!” said Rose.




“And do you like eating vegetables from the garden, Rocky?” Amma asked.

“Who do you think keeps the vegetables safe from hungry bugs?” Amma asked.



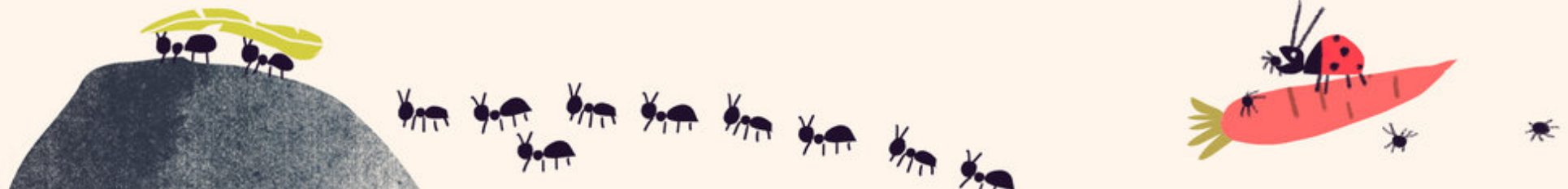
“And the ants,” Amma said. They take away all the rubbish.”
