

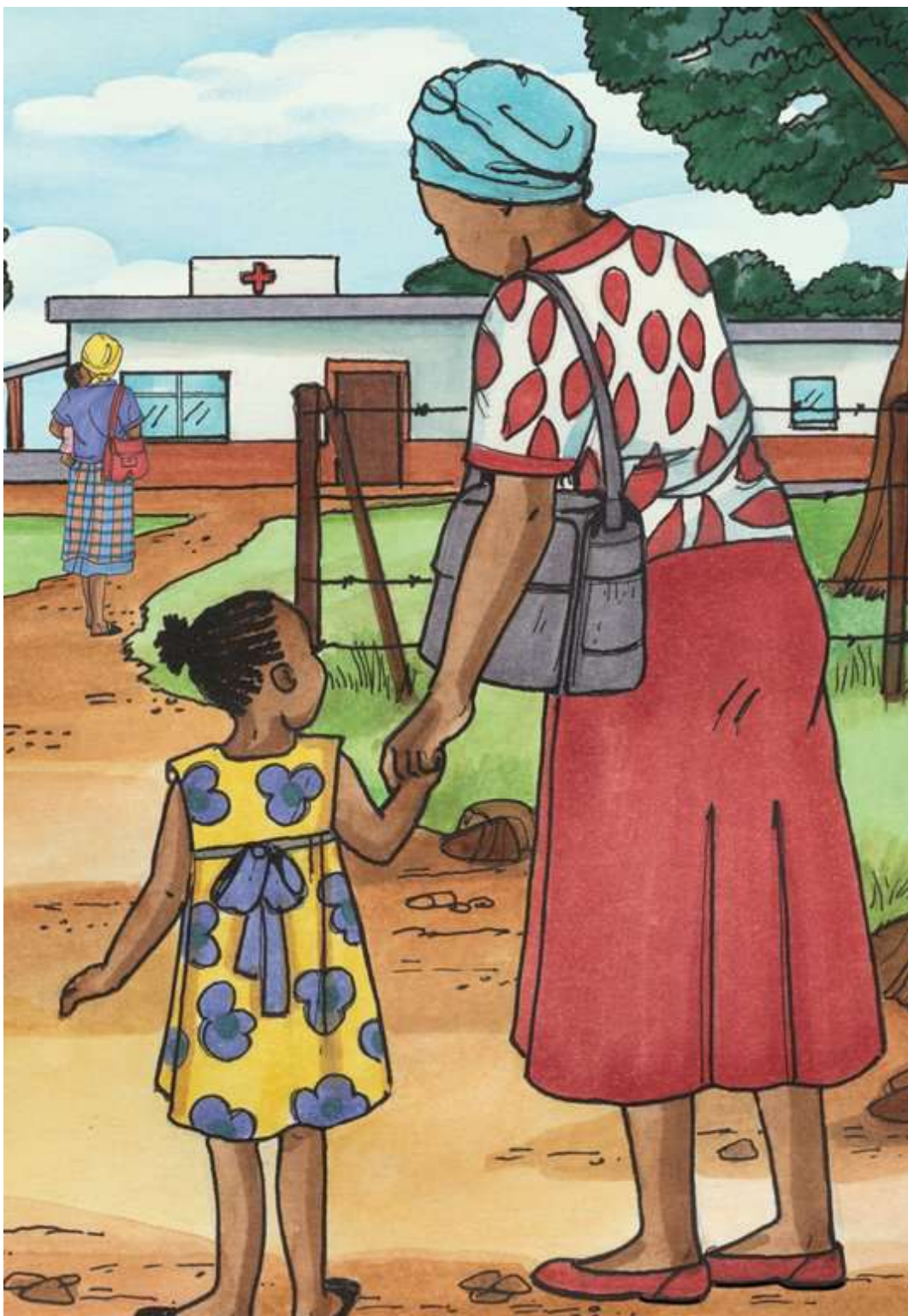


# Doctor, Why Do I Have Four Eyes?

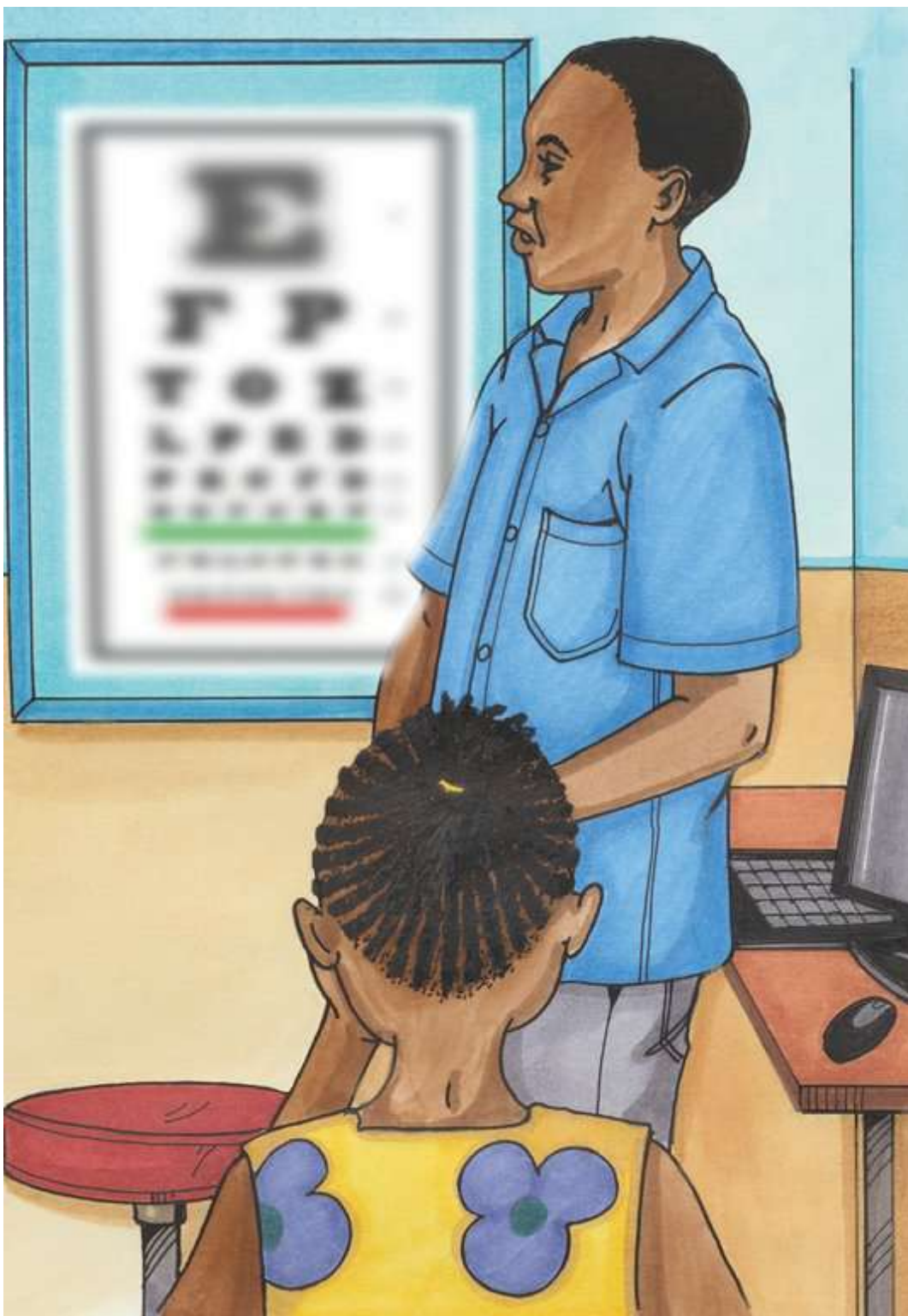

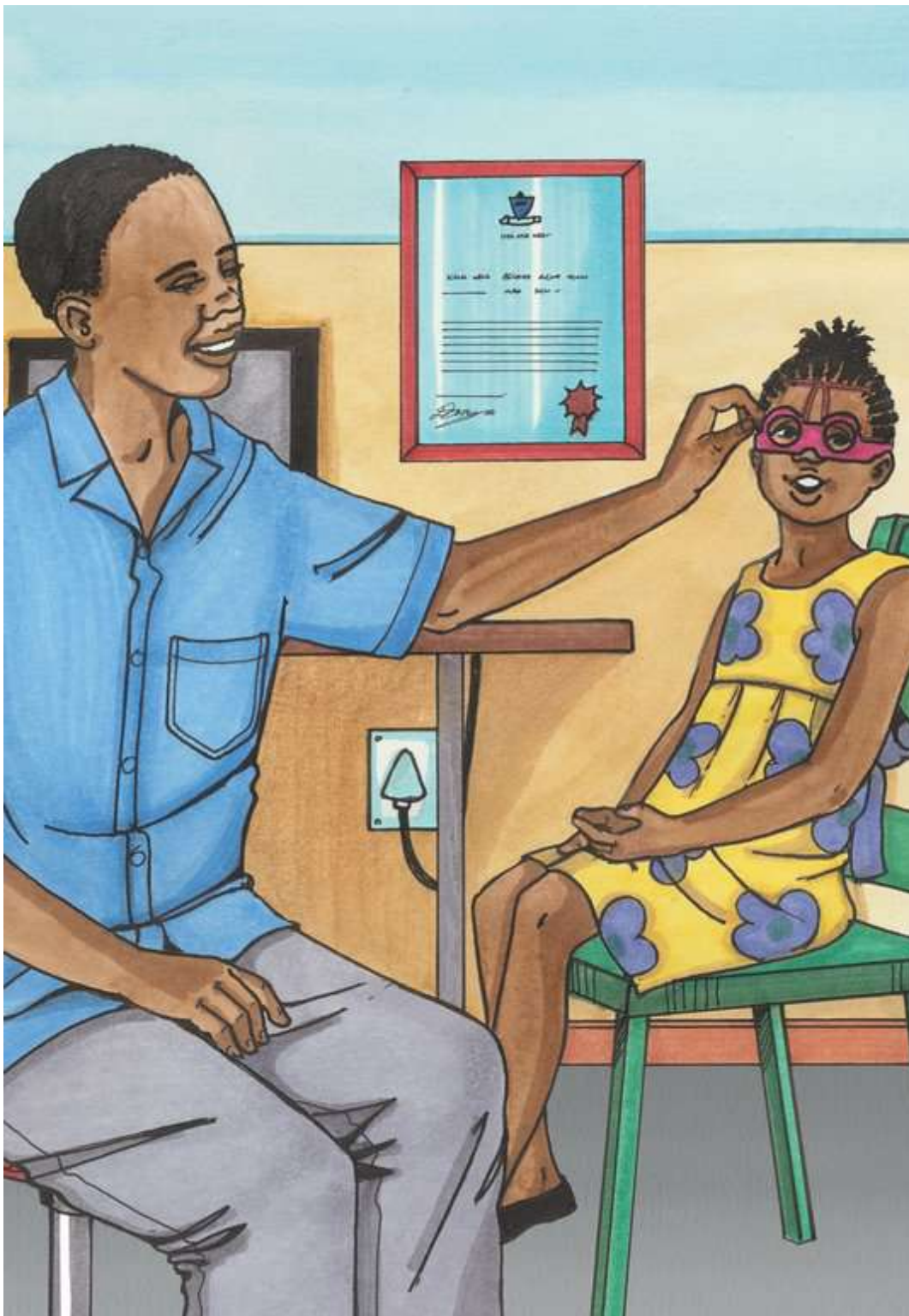
Lisa told her mom that her eyes were acting strange, so they went to the hospital.

When Lisa said she couldn't see the letters, the doctor explained that she was not sick. Her eyesight was bad.

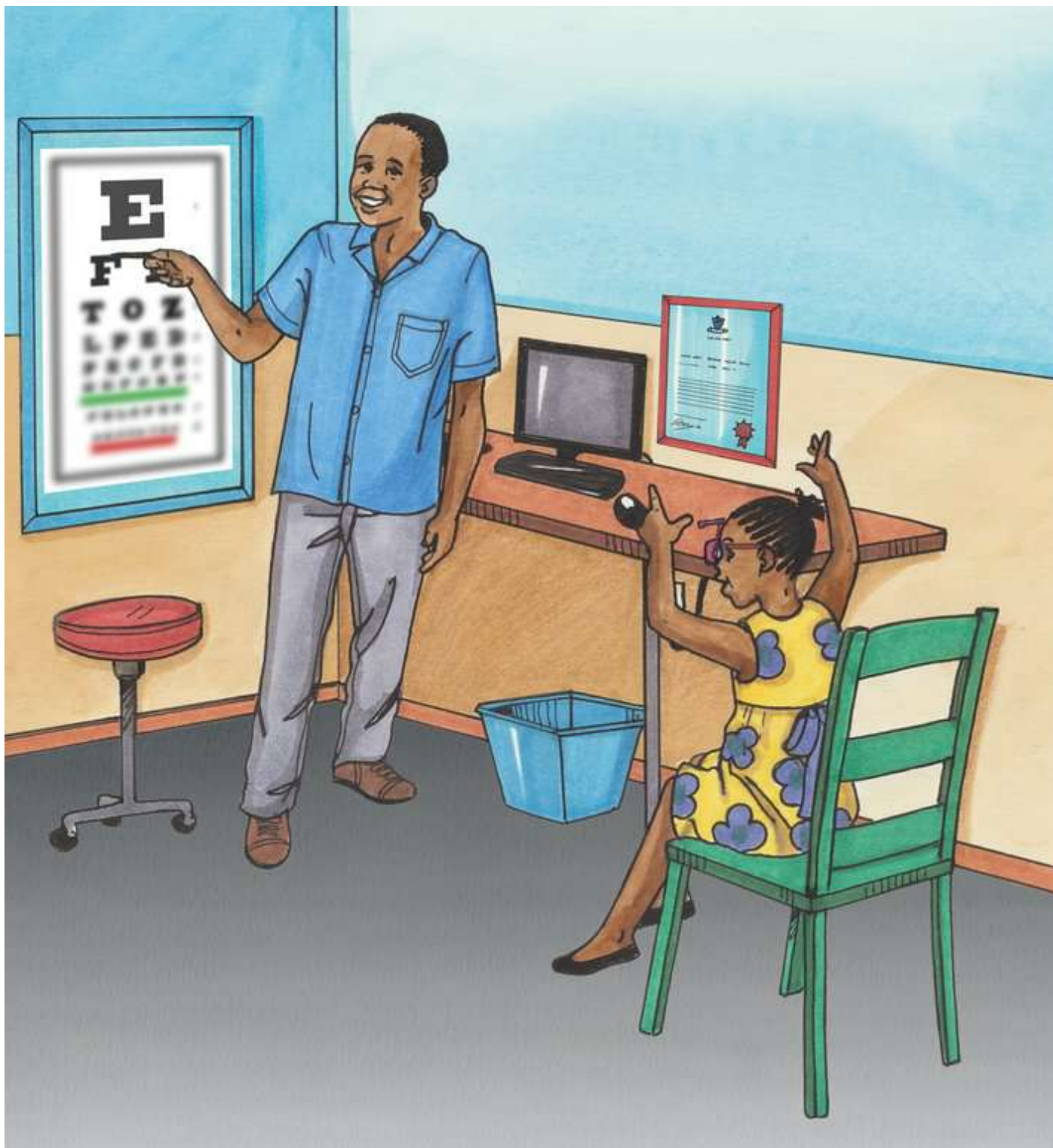


"Doctor, why do I have four eyes?" said Lisa.

The doctor explained that she didn't have four eyes. She was wearing eyeglasses!

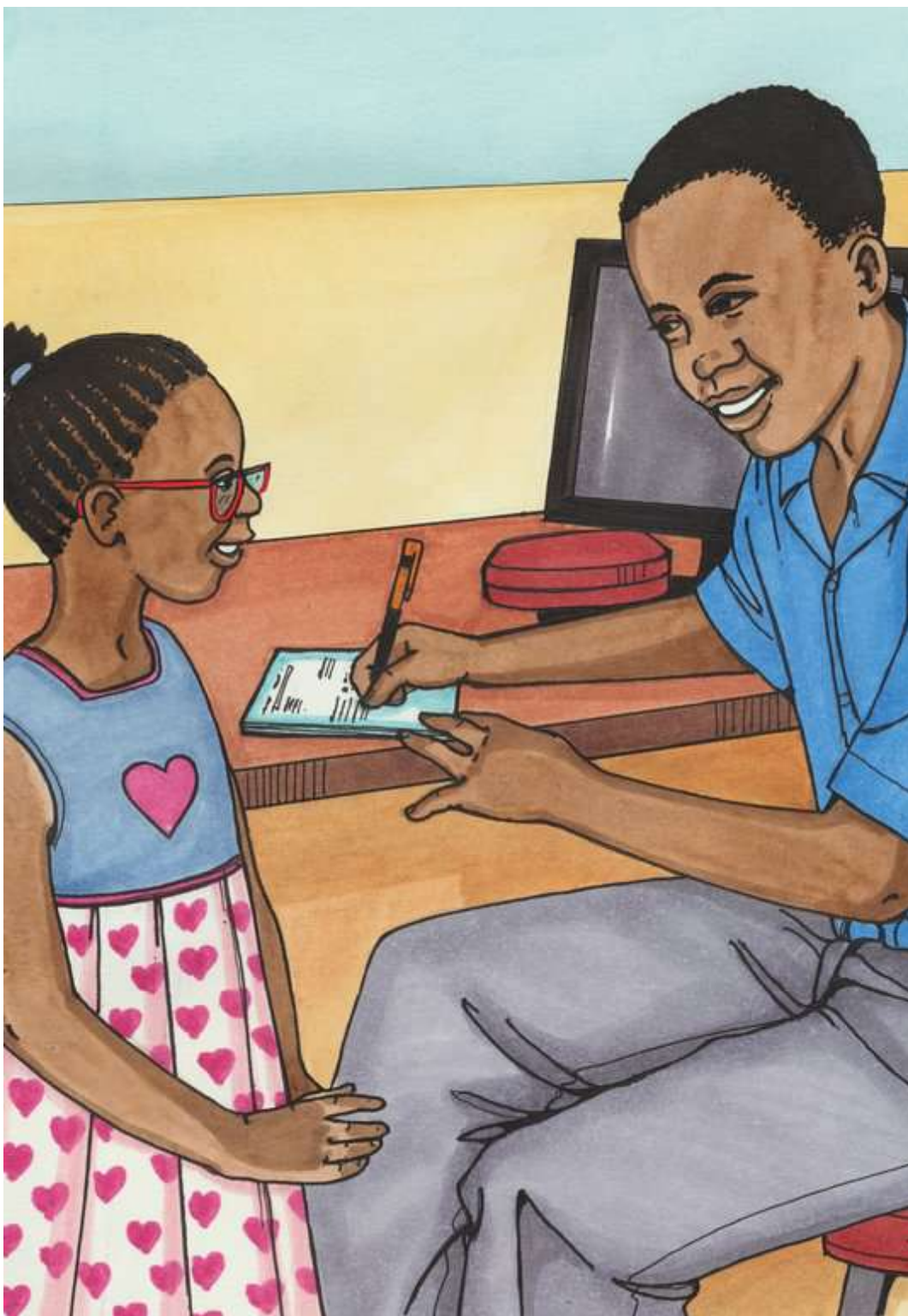
Eyeglasses are worn to help people with poor eyesight see better.
