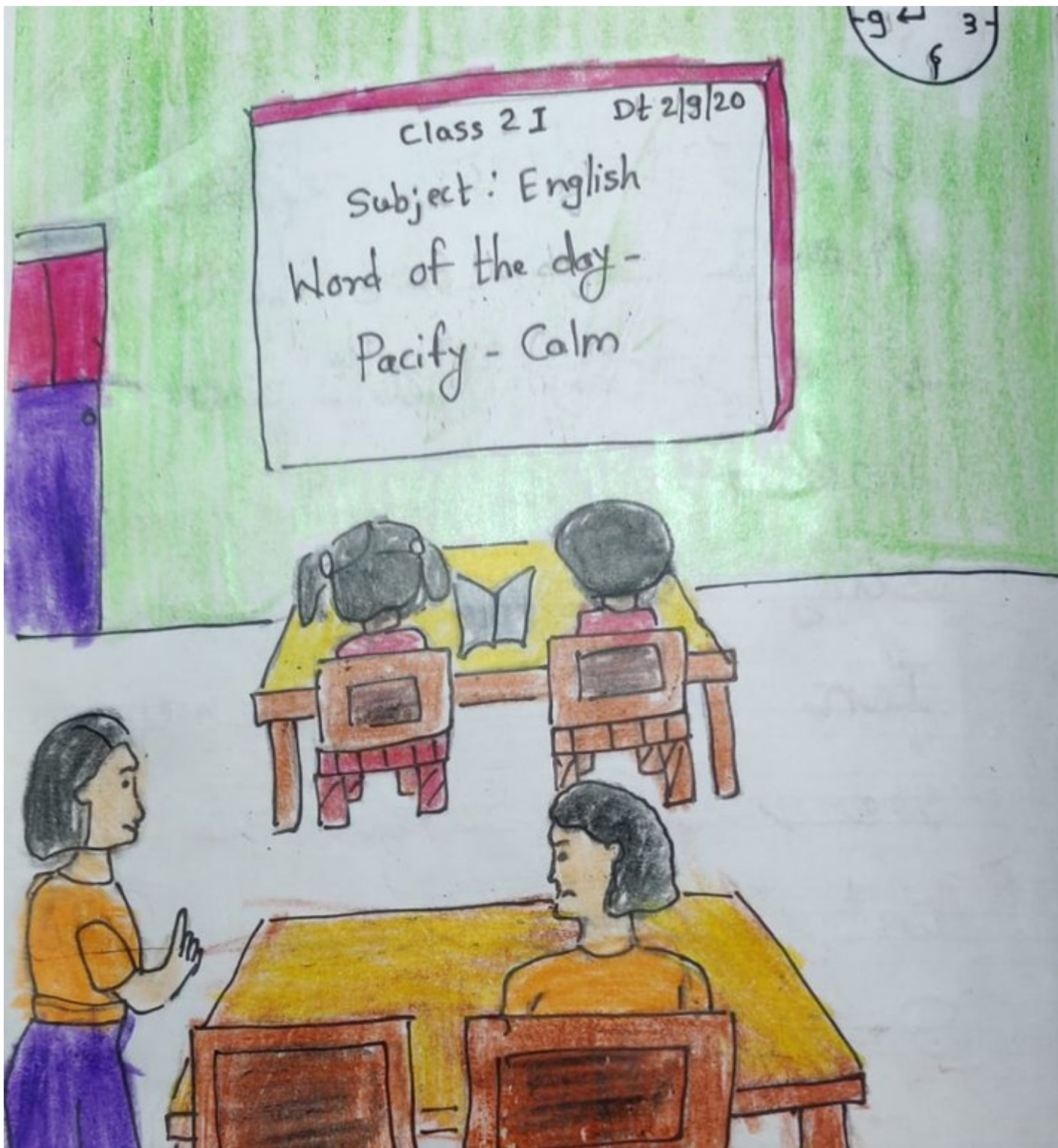
Dolly was a rude girl.
