






"Es una resbaladilla", dice mamá.

"¿Puedo subirme?" Pregunta Tumi.


"¡Por supuesto!" Dice mamá.





"Weeeee!"






"Mira mamá, me muevo como un **mono.**"

"¡Sí!" Dice el niño.




"Soy Tumi".
