—¡Helados! ¡Helados! —gritaba el vendedor.

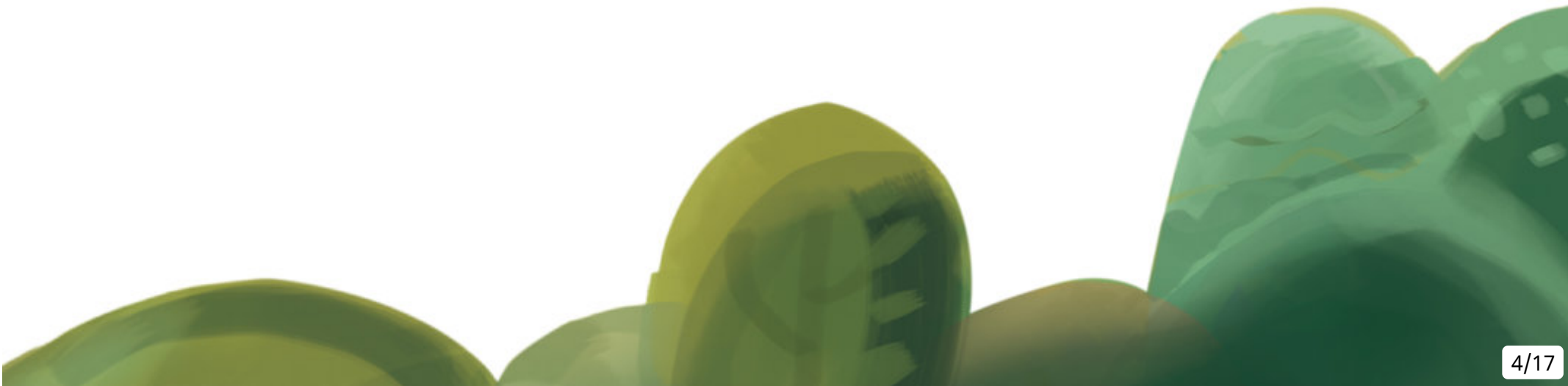
Reba corrió hacia su mamá.

una barra de jabón.

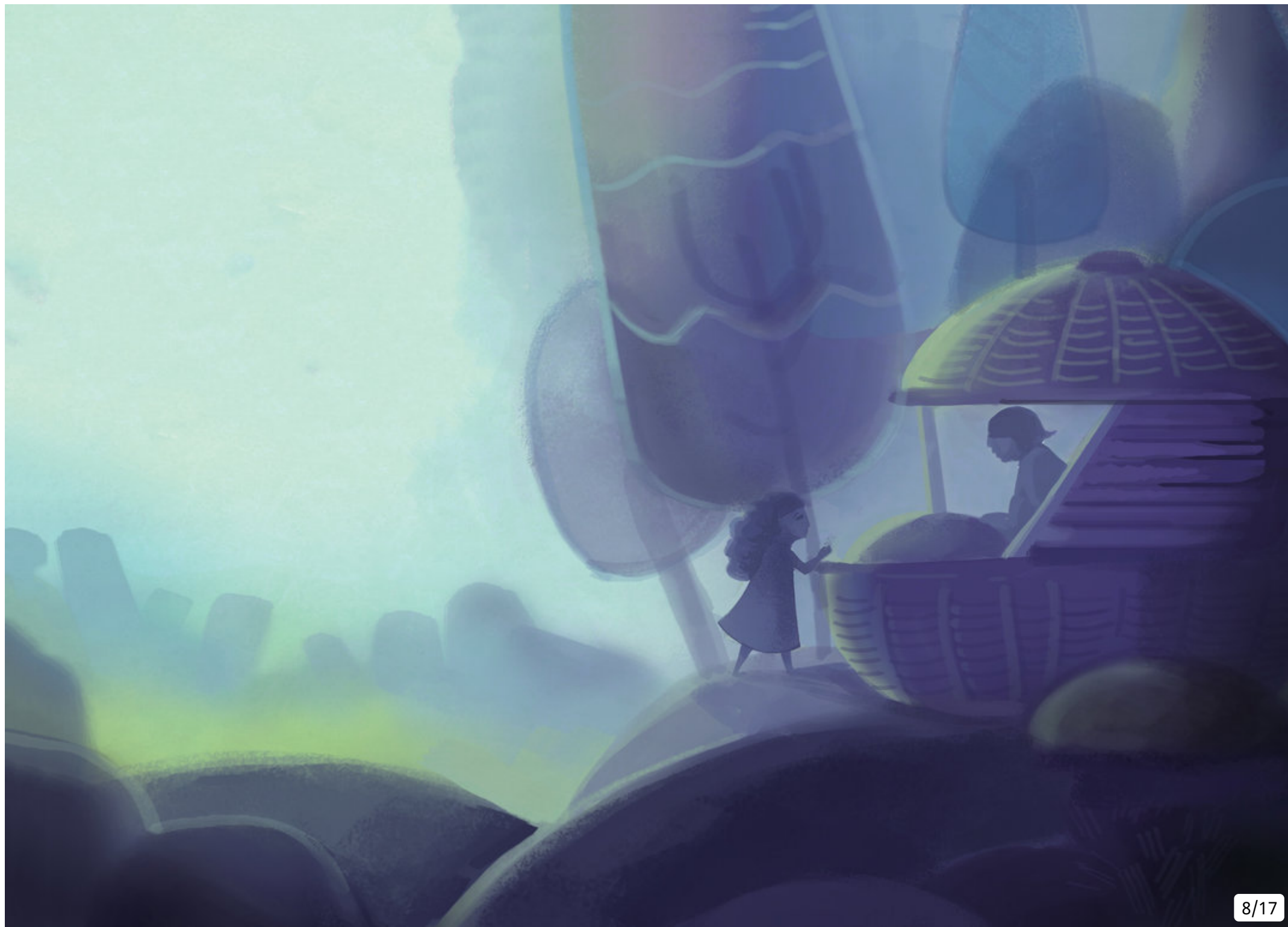
*Taka es el nombre de la moneda usada en Bangladesh.
