Silence


sigh-lun-ss

They took a picture as a **memento** of the day.





There goes the donkey with its blonde hair, As the picnic eating family sees him, The peaceful atmosphere surrounds there, The dog steals a sandwich from the food bin.




Timmy's best friend waves hello, While Timmy eats his breakfast, He eats quickly and then goes, I think he ate a little too fast!

The family goes out together, Everyone walks in a line, The father thinks he is clever, The baby wants to try and climb.




The sea looks warm for swimming, The dog leaps in the pool, Everyone is winning, Paddling and keeping cool.
