"¿Un regalo del océano? "Coral se sumerge en el río. Agua fría se arremolina alrededor de su cuerpo.




Coral y los peces arcoiris nadan y nadan. Siguen nadando. A través del río ...



... sobre una enorme ola ...


... y en el *océano* .



Finalmente, llegan al corazón del océano.




Coral apenas puede creer lo que ve.

El agua del mar es fresca y fresca. Se envuelve alrededor de Coral como un dulce abrazo.




Entonces, se abre una puerta al mundo submarino.


Coral piensa: "Nunca he visto tanta luz".

Todos los que ella conoce tienen su propio sueño.


