Yo se! Ese dulce olor es de aqui! De este nuevo puesto del dulces. El dulce olor es de estos gulab jamoons frescos!

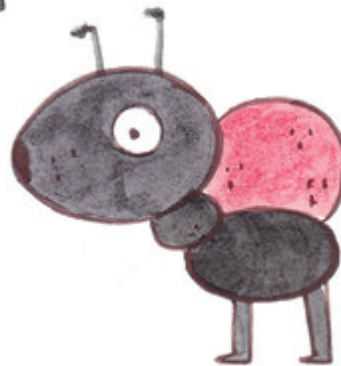
