




Words Matter(A rhyme story)

Once upon a time long long ago, In a small village lived a cuckoo and crow.


Although best friends, the cuckoo spoke softly and sweetly to all, But the crow always used harsh words and was rude to big and small.

Everyone loved the cuckoo and disliked the crow, But the reason behind this, the crow did not know.




One day the crow and the cuckoo decided to go on a picnic, They started making plans and packing bags quick.


They decided to bake a cake and sandwiches and more, For this they needed some ingredients from the grocery store.
