Point to letters and words as you read aloud




In the big city where tall buildings touch the sky and cars zoom like busy ants, there lives a girl named Veronica.

"Get out from under that blanket. We have to get going to the Battle of the Flowers. They are expecting me to help!"


Mac smiles at Roni, gives her a hand, and a little hug.




Roni hides behind a bouquet of flowers.

Roni bravely steps up into the bus.








Roni covers her ears!





Her mom holds her tight and points ahead where a fire truck has stopped. It extends its ladder up a tree to a stuck kitten.

As they pass by on the bus, a firefighter bring


As they pass by on the bus, a firefighter brings the cat down to safety.












"Roni," says Mac. "Aren't you scared of all this noise?"
