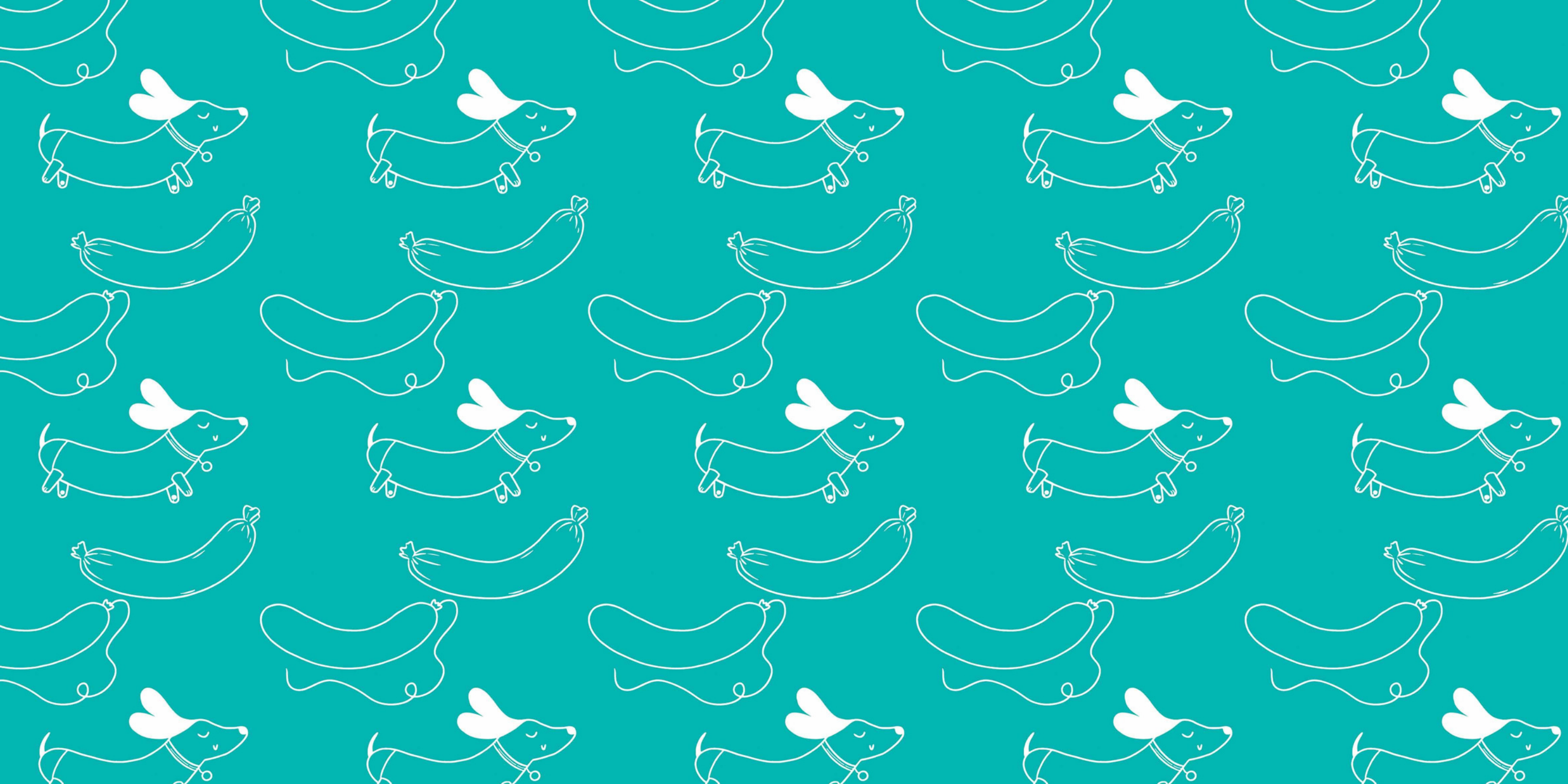

"¡Sí, Demsi!"

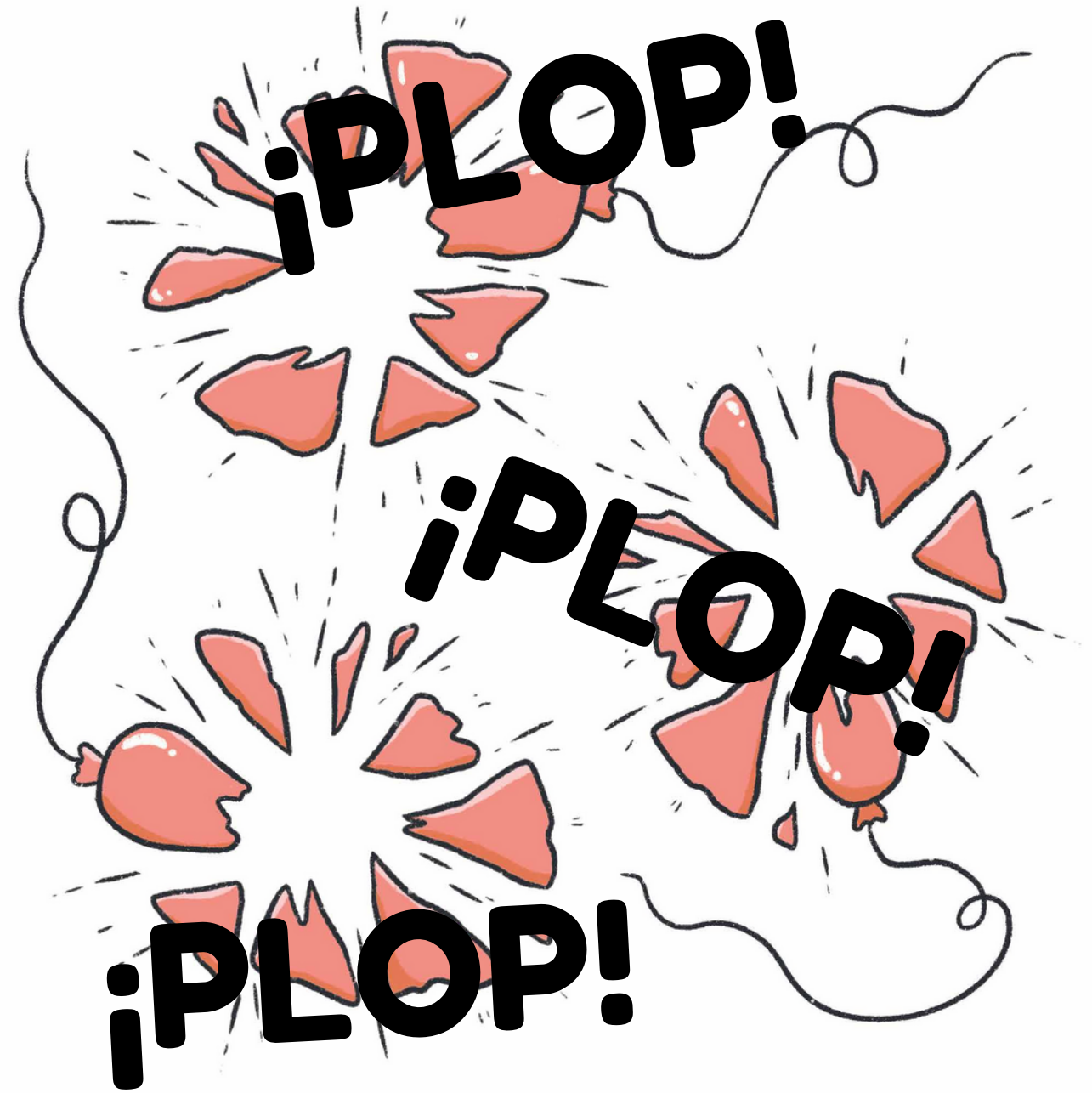

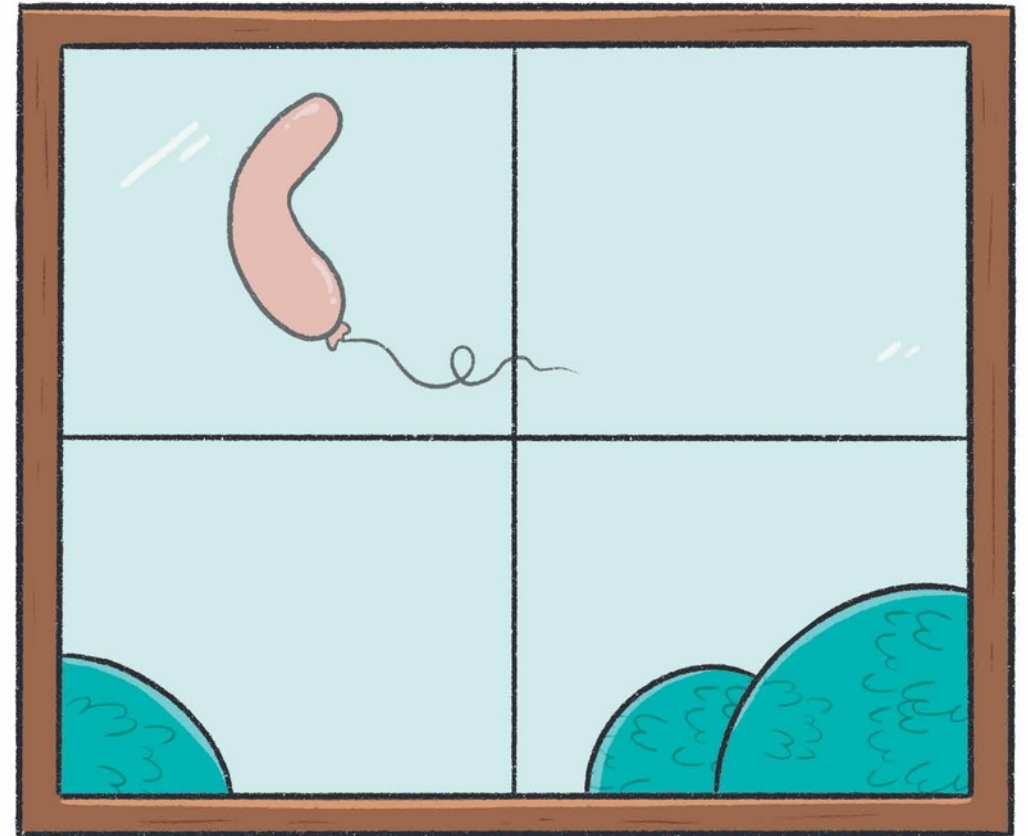

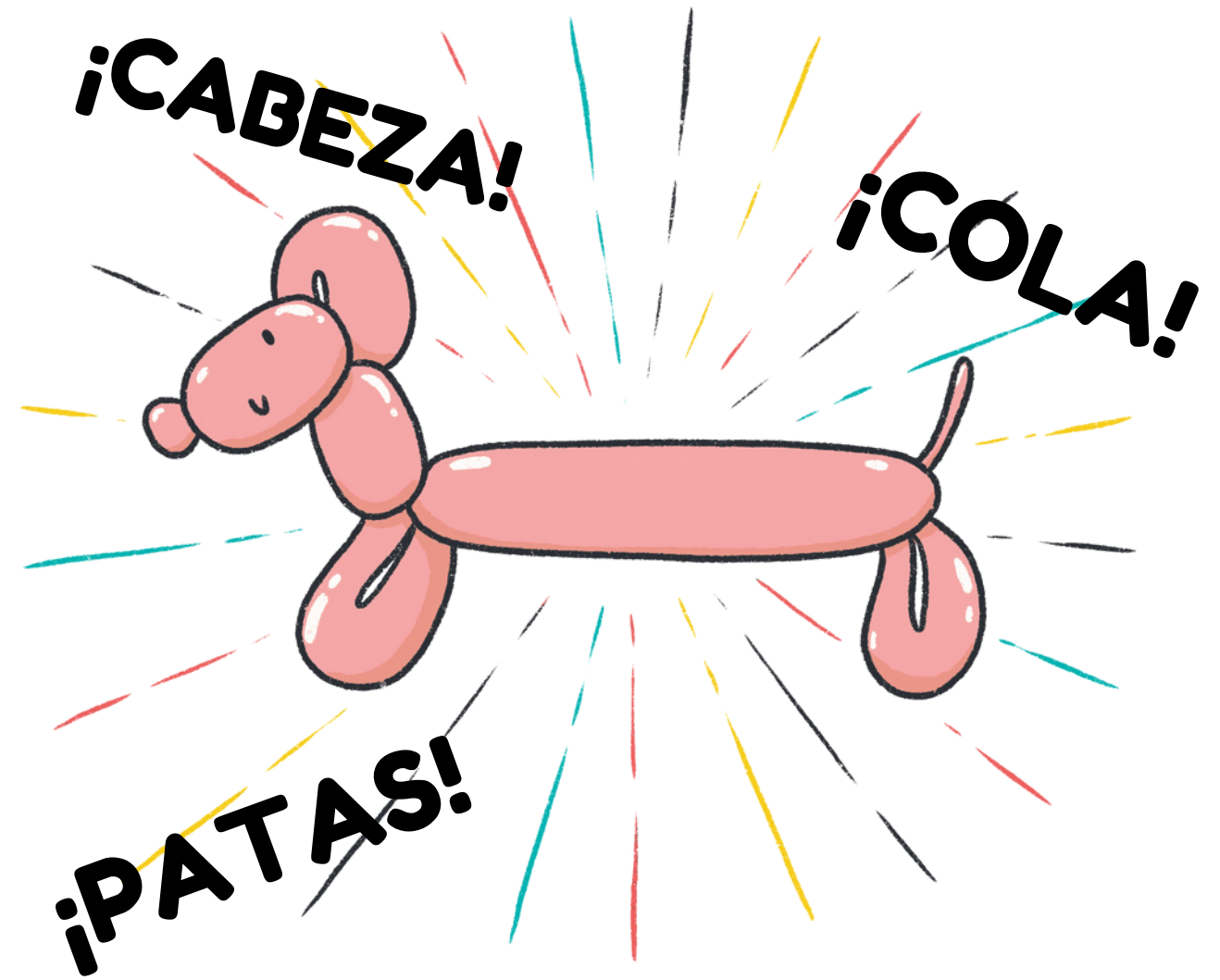

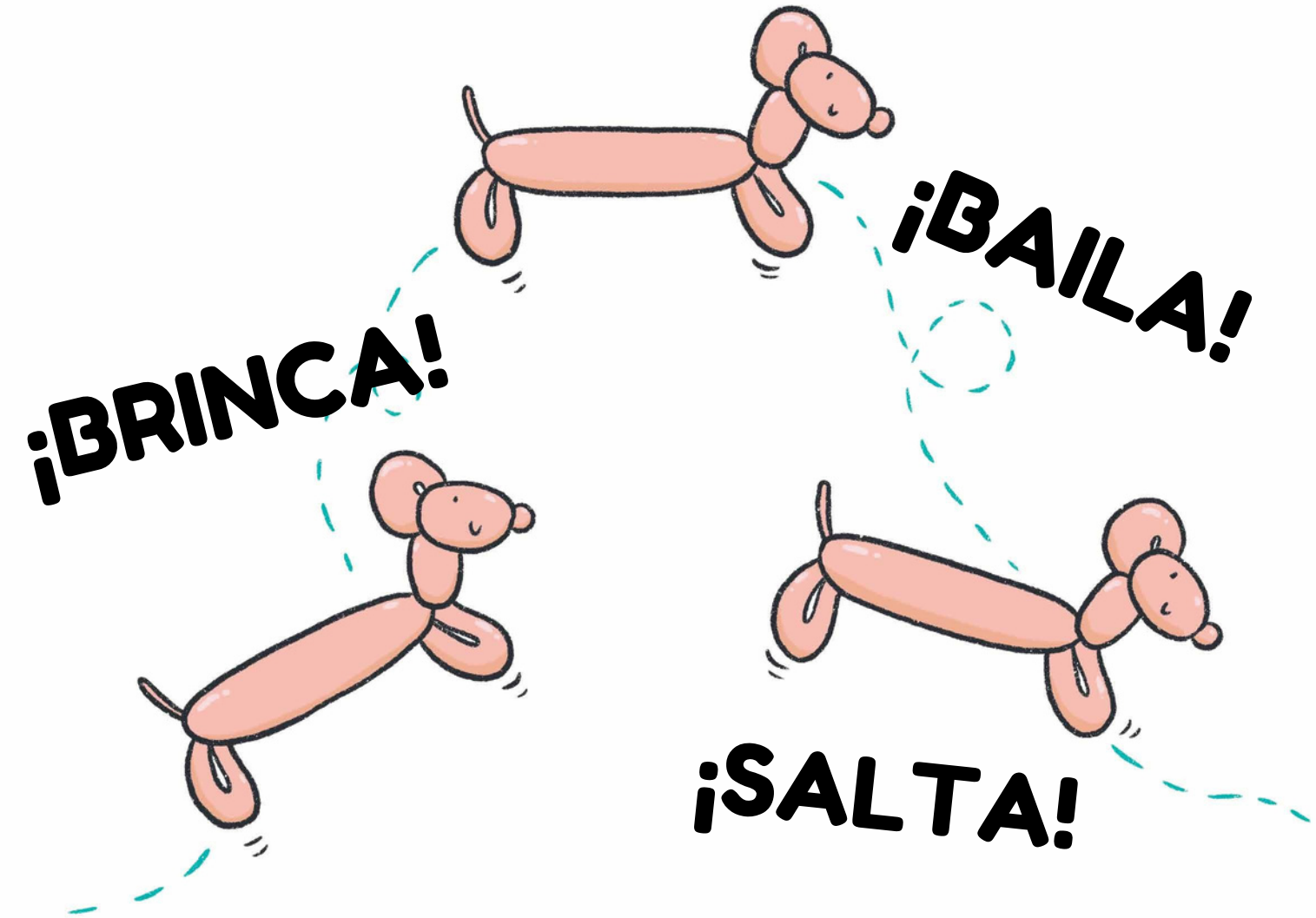
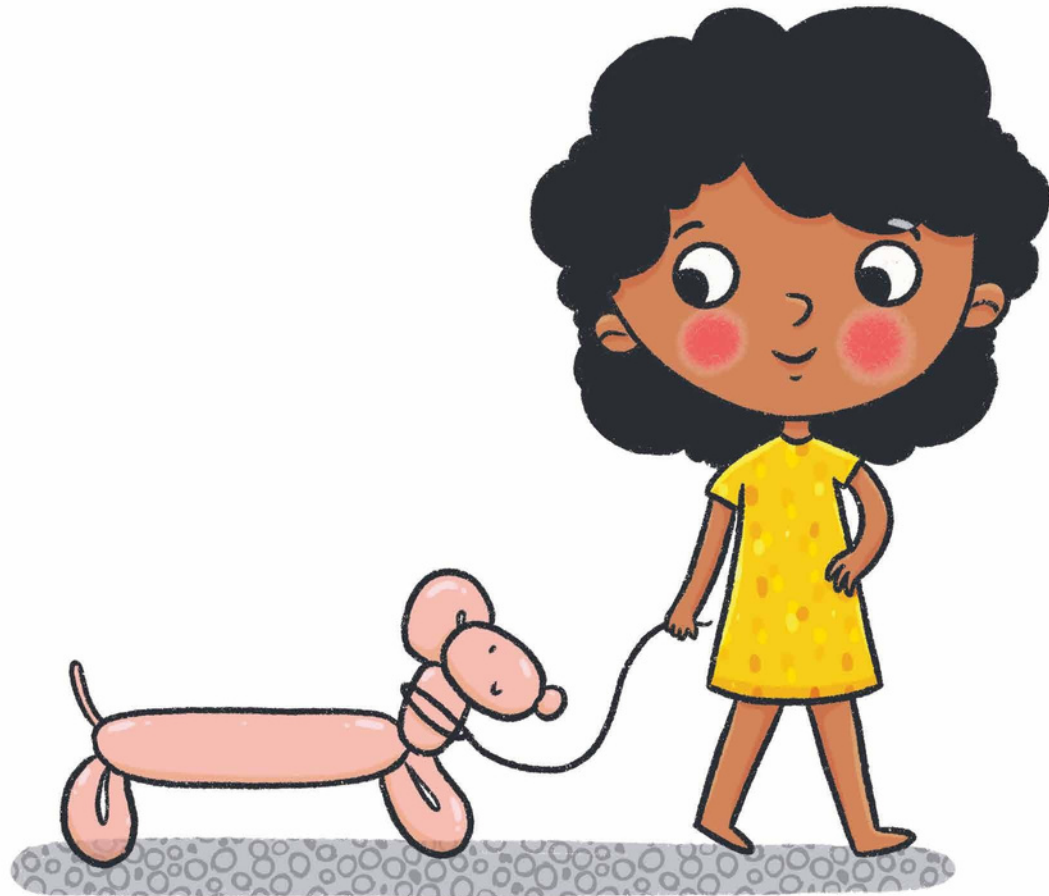

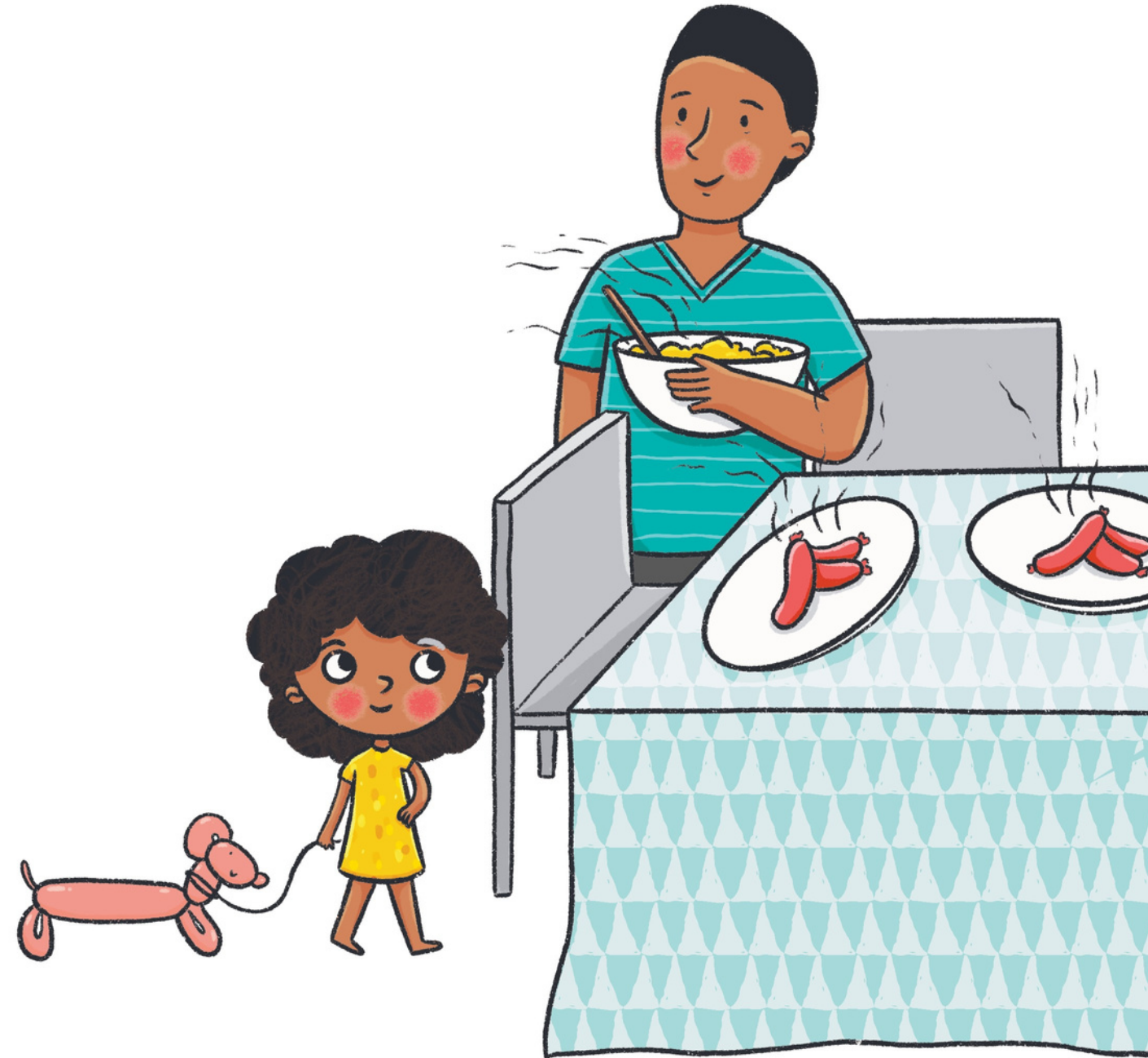


Demsi y su perro salchicha
